New Business – Libby with Mesa Land Trust (MLT) updated the group on the Monument Road vision. Building on the support of the Three Sisters Project. Three landowners have approached MLT about purchasing their property. One would like to put a conservation easement on their property. Want to work with others that have already worked on trail alignment (Trent Prall with City, Bill Taylor with Mesa County and UTC). Will be meeting with various groups over the next couple of months. Developing vision over the summer.

Master Plan Approval – Want to have an open house in May (16th or 23rd) then go to planning committee workshops, City Council, County Commissioners and Town Board. (Multi-purpose Room 4:00pm to 6:00pm or 4:00pm to 7:00pm).

Recruiting new members – everyone needs to be heavily recruiting new members.

29 Road safety concerns – crossing 29 Road from C $\frac{1}{2}$ Road. Issue discussed at trail summit and RFC received an email about safety concerns from a dad trying to cross with his family. Temporary solutions won't make the situation better.

Prioritized road for sweeping – Jim Nall with Mesa County asked the group to come up with a prioritized list.

RFC workshop follow up – Master Plan approval and whether to become a commission.

Where does UTC go from here? Group feels need to get new members first and then do more research. Concerns about other trails group popping up – County's new Built Environment, UTC will participate and Grand Valley Bikes and Grand Valley Trail Alliance.

Public Comment – Jody updated on Bike Share. Todd with GVT will contact B Share and another company to come and talk to the group including Grand Valley Bikes and CMU.

Julie asked Jody about the TAC (Technical Advisory Committee) and should UTC be involved. Todd felt that probably not since there is so much other business covered that no one would want to continue.
