NOTE: A temporary liquor license permit may be issued only if a completed application for a transfer of ownership along with all required documentation and associated fees have been submitted and accepted by the City of Grand Junction, City Clerk's Office, 250 N. 5th Street, Grand Junction, CO 81501.

A temporary permit is valid until such time as the application to transfer ownership of the license to the applicant is granted or denied or for one hundred twenty days (120), whichever occurs first; except that, if the application to transfer the license has not been granted or denied within the one-hundred-twenty-day (120) period and the transferee demonstrates good cause, the local licensing authority may extend, in its discretion, the validity of said permit for an additional period not to exceed sixty (60) days.

This permit may be canceled, revoked, or summarily suspended if the Local or State Licensing Authority determines there is probable cause to believe that the transferee has violated any provision of the Colorado Liquor/Beer Code, or has violated any rule or regulation adopted by the Local or State Licensing Authority, or has failed to truthfully disclose those matters required pursuant to the application forms.
