RESOLUTION NO. 45-19

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING INSURANCE FOR OPERATION BY  
ADRENALINE ADVENTURE COMPANY OF UTILITY TYPE VEHICLES (UTVs)  
ON PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

**Recitals:**

As required by Ordinance 4859 Adrenaline Adventure Company, by and through its insurer, National Interstate Insurance Company, provided the City Attorney a Certificate of Liability Insurance that meets the statutory (C.R.S. 42-7-103(2)) mandatory minimum liability coverage for operation of its utility type vehicles (UTVs) on the public right-of-way as allowed by Ordinance 4859.

Furthermore, the Certificate establishes commercial general liability coverage of:

Bodily Injury (per person)	\$100,000
Bodily Injury (per accident)	\$300,000
Property Damage (per accident)	\$ 50,000

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

Effective July 11, 2019, Adrenaline Adventure has satisfied the specific condition of Ordinance 4859 to provide the mandatory, statutory minimum coverage for operation of utility type vehicles (UTVs) on the public right-of-way.

Other conditions, terms and requirements of the Ordinance shall be separately established and enforced as provided thereby and therein.
