#### HEARING OFFICER SAM D. STARRITT

### I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver and Deputy City Clerk Selestina Sandoval.



will ensure no alcohol leaves or is brought in to the licensed area. A booth will be set up near the beer
service area and will be staffed with TIPSs trained volunteers and CMU staff who will ID and wristband only
those over 21 years of age. All servers will also be TIPs trained and will only serve those wearing a age verified wristband. If they should question the age of an attendee they will do a second ID check. If
an attendee does not have a wristband they will be sent back to ID station. All Citadel officers and trained
volunteers will be constantly monitoring the conduct and intoxication of attendees.
8. How will security personnel be identified?  They will all be easy to identify in security uniform or CMU alumni volunteer t-shirts.


