**MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 21, 2019, 2:00 P.M.**

HEARING OFFICER SAM D. STARRITT

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver and Deputy City Clerk Selestina Sandoval.

II. APPLICATIONS TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

Hearing Officer Starritt started the meeting with the renewal application for Twisted Turtle. Deputy City Clerk Sandoval had informed him that Twisted Turtle did not have any employees attend the Responsible Alcohol Server Training since their last renewal, which was agreed to at that meeting due to violations the previous year. Manager Will Jones was present and assured Hearing Officer Starritt that the employees had received TIPS certification and that he had attended a Responsible Alcohol Server Training with the City. It was agreed that he would present his certificate to the City Clerk's Office as proof of the training.

1. Name of Event: Tour de Rock

2. How many attendees are expected at the event? 750

3. Has the event been held in the past? If so, how many years? Yes - 2 Years

4. Have there ever been any violations or citations issued during the event in the past?
There have been no citations at either of the previous events.

5. Describe the premises at which the event will take place.
Main Street, Downtown Grand Junction. Please see attached map for specific streets and closures.

6. What type of and how many security will be provided at this event and how will they be identified?
2 GJPD in uniform, 14 hired Citadel security officers in uniform, and 10 or more alumni board volunteers in CMU alumni t-shirts.

7. What is the Control Plan for security at this event? (Use additional sheet if necessary)
The perimeter of the event will be fenced with a volunteer and a security guard at each entry/exit point. They will ensure no alcohol leaves or is brought in to the licensed area. A booth will be set up near the beer service area and will be staffed with TIPSs trained volunteers and CMU staff who will ID and wristband only those over 21 years of age. All servers will also be TIPS trained and will only serve those wearing a age verified wristband. If they should question the age of an attendee they will do a second ID check. If an attendee does not have a wristband they will be sent back to ID station. All Citadel officers and trained volunteers will be constantly monitoring the conduct and intoxication of attendees.

8. How will security personnel be identified?
They will all be easy to identify in security uniform or CMU alumni volunteer t-shirts.

9. If this event is being held outdoors, how will the exterior boundaries of the premises be marked (i.e., roped, fenced, etc.)?
The event will be held outdoors. The exterior boundaries of the premise will be fenced between existing buildings. Please see attached map for details. Area will be completely fenced with PED fencing.

10. What method will be used in checking identification for proper age of attendees (i.e., at the door, at the bar, etc.) and how will underage patrons be identified so as not to be served alcohol beverages (i.e., stamp or mark on the hand, etc.)

The ID check station will be separate from service station. Each attendee will show their ID and be verified as 21+. If they are 21 they will be wristbanded. Only those with wristbands will be able to buy beer tickets / drinks.

11. How will the conduct and level of intoxication of attendees be monitored and by whom?

Conduct and level of intoxication will be monitored by all security guards, and trained volunteers serving. Servers will not serve those who appear to be intoxicated.

12. Have the volunteers or members of your organization been trained in the sale/service of alcohol beverages?

Yes. Volunteers have attended City of Grand Junction Safe Server Training or are TIPs trained.

13. What types of alternate beverages and food/snacks will be available?

There will be water available to all attendees. Within the area there will be food vendor food trucks available with a variety of food to purchase.

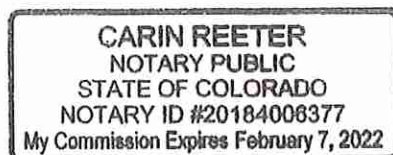

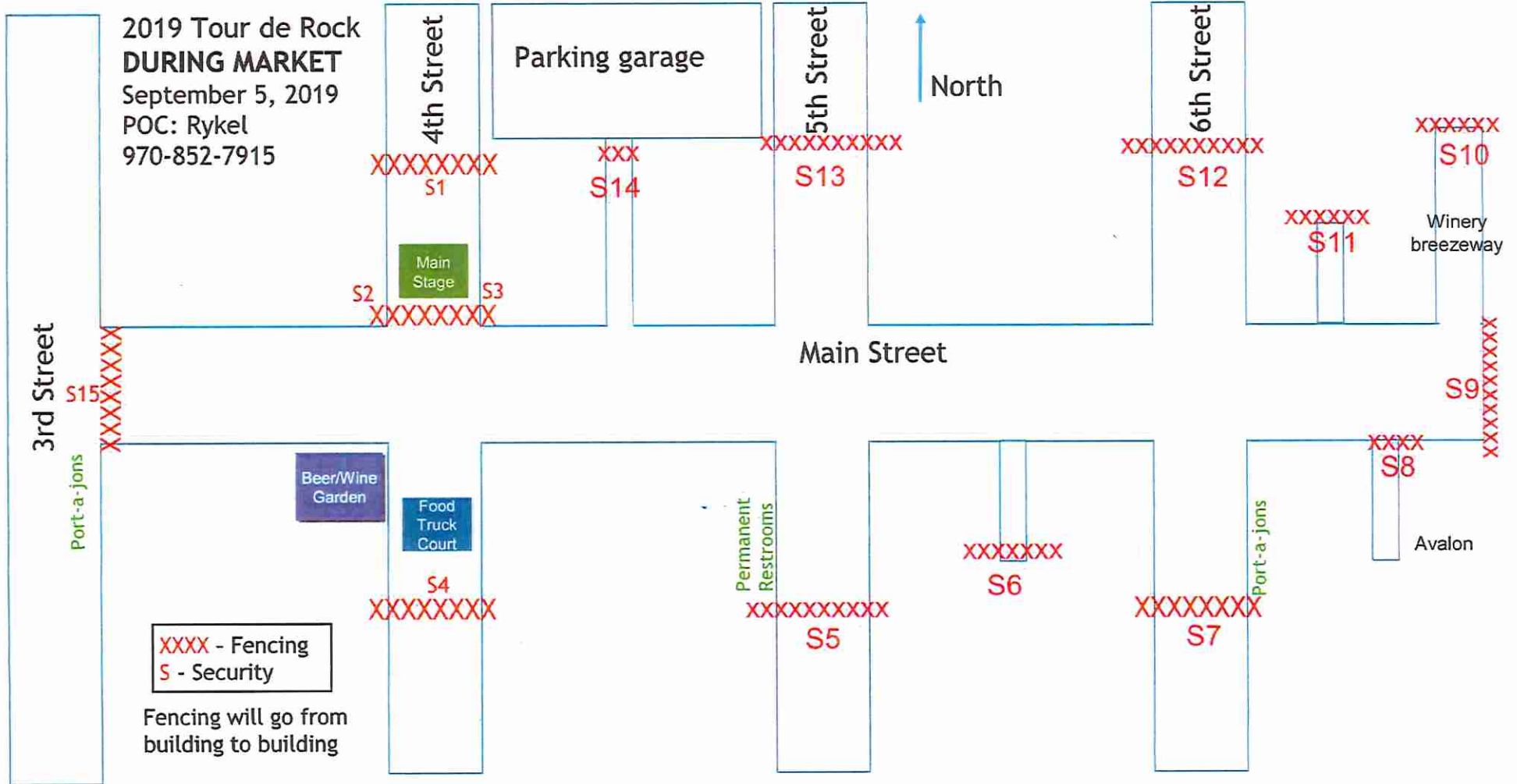

There have never been any citations or violations at any of the past events.

The event will be held outside at Lincoln Park. Please see attached map for details and specific area.
Entire area will be fenced.

6. What type of and how many security will be provided at this event and how will they be identified?
21 CMU Athletics Coaches and CMU Athletics Administration in bright matching t-shirts.

7. What is the Control Plan for security at this event? (Use additional sheet if necessary)
The perimeter of this event will be fenced and will only have one entry/exit to ensure no alcohol leaves or enters the premise. The entrance will have TIPs trained volunteers checking ID and wristbanding those 21+. At the service area only people with wristbands will be served. All servers will be TIPs trained or have taken the City of Grand Junction Safe Server Training. Should the trained servers question the age of an attendee they will again ID them at the serving station. We will have 21 athletics coaches and administration and additional volunteers walking the event to monitor conduct in addition to the trained servers who will help monitor intoxication.

8. How will security personnel be identified?
Coaches, athletics administration, and volunteers will be in matching bright t-shirts.

9. If this event is being held outdoors, how will the exterior boundaries of the premises be marked (i.e., roped, fenced, etc.)?
The entire perimeter will be fenced. Please see attached map for details.

10. What method will be used in checking identification for proper age of attendees (i.e., at the door, at the bar, etc.) and how will underage patrons be identified so as not to be served alcohol beverages (i.e., stamp or mark on the hand, etc.)

Central Distributing and High Country Beverages will be serving all alcohol. Only those who have been age verified and wristbanded will be served. If asked they will need to show their ID again at the service station.

11. How will the conduct and level of intoxication of attendees be monitored and by whom?

Conduct and intoxication will be monitored by all 21 coaches, additional volunteers, and those serving the beer.

12. Have the volunteers or members of your organization been trained in the sale/service of alcohol beverages?

Yes volunteers and members checking ID and serving, as well as security will have been trained for the event.

There will be unlimited steak and crab available to everyone, toast, coffee and water.

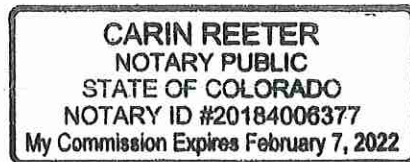

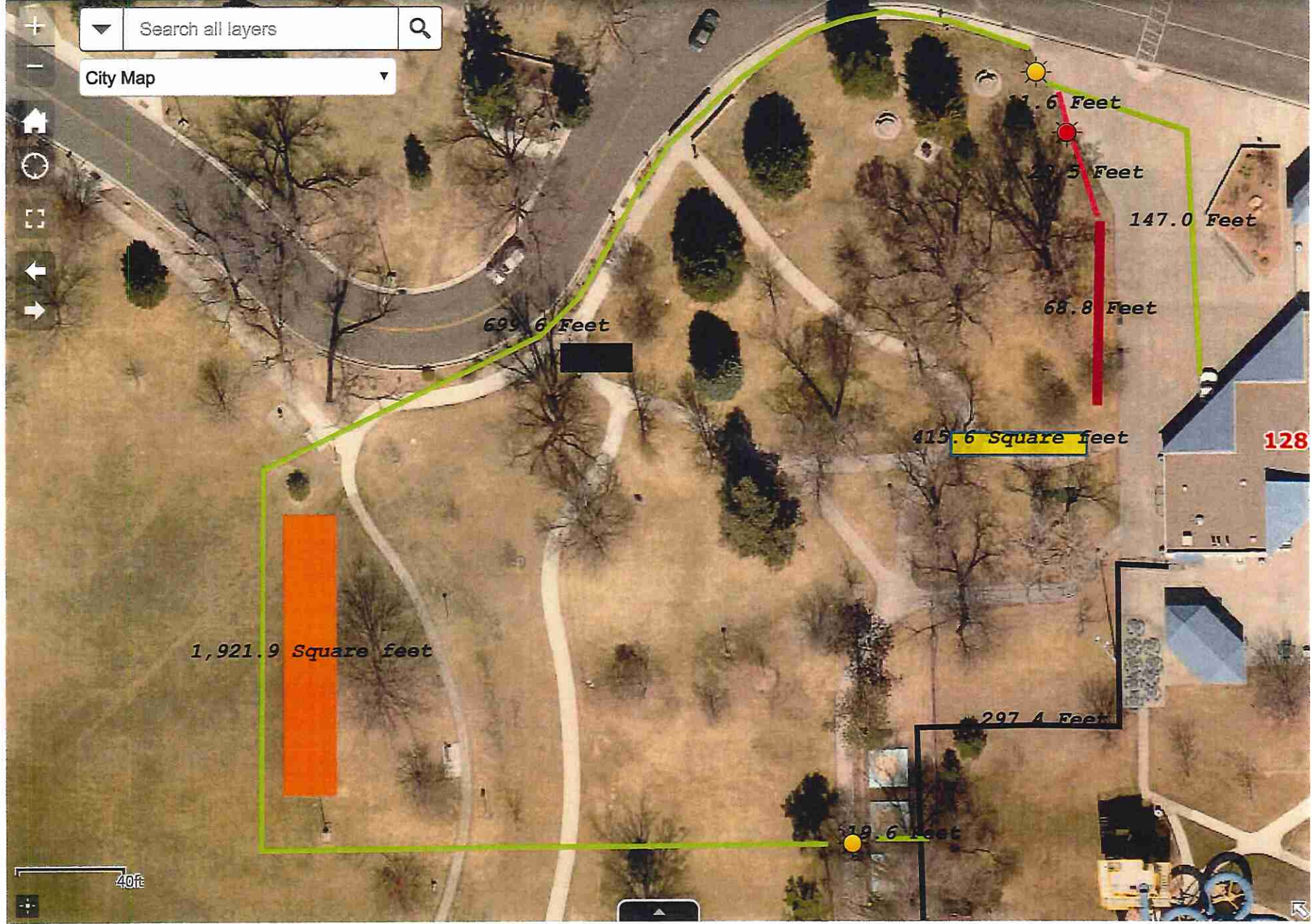

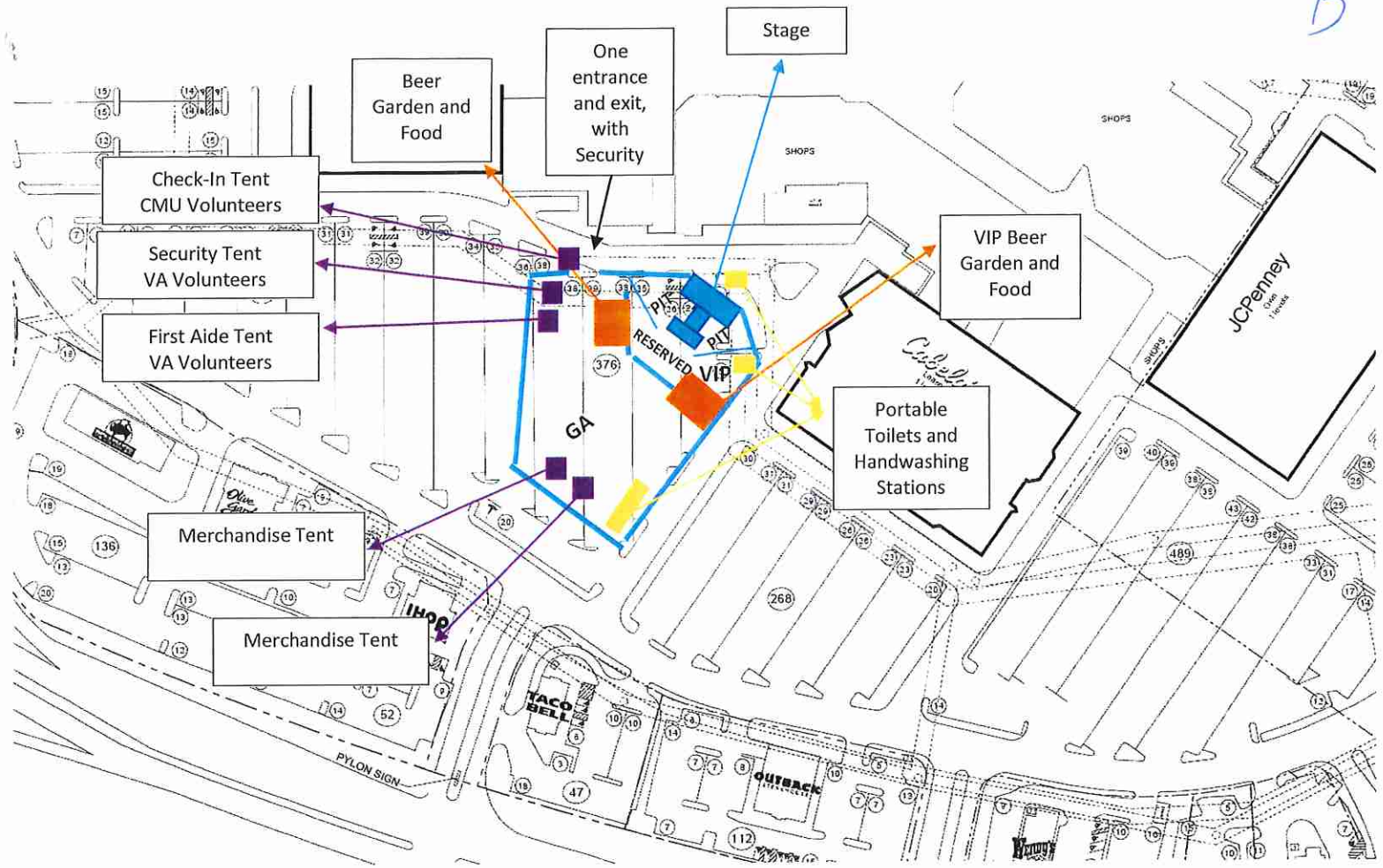
