


Mt. Garfield and Little Bookcliffs

Named for President James Garfield and part of the Little Bookcliffs, prominent Mount Garfield lies northeast of the City. A herd of 80 to 120 wild horses roam a large area of the Little Bookcliffs.

Colorado National Monument

Colorado National Monument is the distinctive natural landform that frames the southwestern backdrop of Grand Junction. The Monument was established in 1911 by Presidential Proclamation. John Otto was its first custodian.

















Early People

Traces of ancient people are still visible in petroglyphs in the Grand Junction area. Later, the Ute Indians populated the area. Their leader was Chief Ouray.




Make your own petroglyph Use the rock face above and design your own petroglyphs.

Diversion Dam


A growing system of canals and ditches, including the Grand Valley Diversion Dam completed in 1916 allowed the City and Grand Valley to prosper.




Grand Junction Railroad Station


Another reason Grand Junction grew was completion of the Denver and Rio Grande Railroad through the City in 1882. The depot that still stands in downtown was constructed in 1905.


The Main Street shopping park was built in 1962. Upon completion, the city was given the All American City Award.


> Art on the Corner was started on Main Street in 1984. Every year new sculptures are put in place and every year the community votes on their favorite one to keep.
