

MINUTES OF GRAND JUNCTION ARTS COMMISSION
OCTOBER 24, 1990 REGULAR MEETING

Meeting called to order by Allison Sarmo.

Colorado Council for Arts and Humanities Grant

Allison presented a letter reporting the grant of \$7,500.00 to the Grand Junction City Council. The funds will be formally accepted by the council on November 7, 1990.

Survey

Larry Mazzeno presented the narrative summary for the survey. It was accepted by the commission with minor corrections. The project is nearing completion.

Consultant Candidates

The commission will hire a consultant to help with the master cultural plan with the funding from the CCAH grant. Two ads will be placed in the Daily Sentinel advertising the position.

There are two candidates currently interested in the position. Mr. Rick Male of Community Resource Center and Ellen Ittelson of Hammer, Siler and George. Interviews will be set up with these candidates and others who might apply.

Arts Development Breakfast

A date of January 19, 1990 is projected. Approximately 250 people are expected to attend. The sight chosen will be the Ramada Inn.

Julie Schroeder-Wright submitted a list of suggested people from the community who are interested in the arts. Members will expand the list by next meeting. The commission would like to have musical accompaniment. Sandra Brown will look for a harpist, or Larry Mazzeno will contact a pianist.

Information Exchange

One of the concerns of the commission is to promote the arts in liaison with other community groups. Allison Sarno contacted Debbie Kovalik of the Grand Junction Visitors Bureau. She shared with the commission pamphlets which are given to travelers about the City. Pat Hoge of the Museum of Western Colorado extended information about the goals of the museum. There are tentative plans to hold some collaborative meetings to share information.

The next meeting will be November 13, 1990. (It may be a breakfast meeting to interview a candidate)
