Minutes of the May 2, 1990 meeting were approved as submitted.

Vic reported on the regional meeting of arts councils in Montrose. Two major issues discussed were:

- 1. The National Endowment for the Arts is being attacked in Congress. It was suggested that letters should be sent to Colorado's Congressional delegation to express support for funding. Ann has information on how to contact members of Congress.
- 2. There is a good possibility of a grant for the Commission after it has been in existence for one year.

Vic also reported Maryo Ewell will be in Grand Junction July 21 and 22 for the Colorado Council for Arts and Humanities Forum.

Ann was recently in Spokane and went to the Spokane Arts Commission. She obtained several good publications which were reviewed by the Commission members.

Vic stated three items needed to be dealt with. They are:

- a. By-laws
 The mission statement should include the phrase "preservation of cultural heritage".
 The name change should be specifically brought to the attention of City Council. Suggested name is Grand Junction Commission on the Arts and Cultural Affairs.
 There were other changes made by the By-laws committee.
 After discussion it was moved by Sandra Brown, seconded by Allison Sarmo, that the proposed by-laws be adopted.
 The motion carried unanimously.
- b. Cultural Organization Questionnaire.
 Allison discussed the status of the Questionnaire. Mary
 Buss presented questions from Judy Prakken, WCCA, that
 might be added to the Questionnaire. The Commission
 discussed the total document and determined the questions
 be grouped to ask of those replying; (1) Who are you?
 (2) Describe your organization. (3) What is your description
 of the community and its needs?
 Allison agreed to retype the Questionnaire and submit it
 to Commission members for review and reaction.
 The Commission will discuss it further at the June 13th
 meeting.
- c. Money
 The Budget Committee presented the proposed budget and
 briefly discussed it. Sandra moved and Allison seconded
 that the proposed budget be completed and forwarded to the
 City Council. The motion was unanimously approved.
