Allison reported on a letter submitted concerning grants for mid-sized communities for planning assistance.

Vic reported that we are now members of the National Assembly of Local Arts Agencies.

The draft of the bylaws was submitted. Allison raised the question of a mission statement. It was suggested that the language, "Statement of Purpose" be changed to read, "Statement of Mission". This will assist grant efforts.

A third member may need to be added to the Executive Committee.

It was agreed that we should meet regularly on the second Wednesday of each month beginning in June. The group may call an additional meeting on the fourth Wednesday of the month if necessary.

The next meeting will take place on May 23, at 7:30 p.m.

Allison distributed a list of art and cultural organizations. Additions were made. Vic suggested that we consider a newsletter later on. Sandra explained the Western Colorado Arts Network.

The response to our survey was not good. It was suggested that we include profit, non-profit, and government-sponsored organizations.

Larry offered his wife, Cindy, to develop a data-base system to process information.

Sandra suggested we begin working on questions for the survey. It was suggested that we ask each organization for names we may have left out.

Ann suggested that we invite organizations to give input to our group. A Committee meeting date was set for 7:00 p.m., May 15, to begin to write the survey. The meeting will take place at Allison's home.

Allison reported that there is going to be a regional meeting of arts councils on May 19 in Montrose. Vic will attend.
