

MINUTES OF COMMISSION ON ARTS AND CULTURE
December 11, 1991 7:30p.m.

Attending: Sandra Brown, Mary Buss, Jody Cole, Larry Mazeno, Ann Sanders, Allison Sarmo, Brenda Swille, and Julie Schroeder-Wright.

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chairperson, Allison Sarmo.

First on the Agenda was the announcement of the new member, Steven Laiche. He is the replacement for John Patterson.

Second on the Agenda was the discussion of hiring a part-time staff on contract basis. Fifteen thousand dollars is a projected budget for this position and finished products. The Commission would like this position to take over some of the responsibilities Allison has done for the last year. The RFP (Request for Proposals) was changed and the following deleted for now: arranging for special meetings; and administration of any other projects the Commission may undertake. Projects for this Consultant will include: Educational opportunities directory/brochures, Update arts organization inventory/brochures, Cultural events calendar, Sponsoring artists' workshops and seminars, and Investigations/research/reports.

Third on the Agenda was the discussion about a letter to all the arts organization, etc. to thank them for their support of the cultural plan. It was approved by all and will be sent out.

New Business: The DDA asked the Commission to judge the Art on the Corner Arts and Crafts Festival in June. The award would be the Best of Show Award. It was voted on and did not pass. The Commission will decline. The National Arts produced a general art video to advertise the Art Council in your city. The Commission might be able to use this along with the video they are producing.

The next scheduled meeting will be January 8, 1991 at 7:00pm at City Hall.
