

MINUTES OF GRAND JUNCTION ARTS COMMISSION
April 10, 1991. 7:30

Discussion on people on the Steering Committee ended with nominating John Tomlinson as Committee Chairman.

The Welcoming Breakfast May 11th was a success and the first scheduled meeting for the Steering Committee will be April 30th, at Lowell Heiny Hall at 7:00 p.m.

Philanthropy Day will bring in twenty foundations from the state of Colorado to observe our city. There will be a slide presentation at the airport, luncheons, speeches, etc. Larry, Sandra, Ann, and Allison will attend the Luncheon at 12:00 p.m. at Liff Auditorium on May 7th in recognition of the Art Commission. There will be a reception at the River Front Park at 4:00p.m. that evening.

The statement "We'er telling them to do too much" was brought up about the Steering Committee. It was decided that it was easier for the Commission to decide on committees and just let the Steering Committee concentrate on getting started with the issues.

The Calendar Committee has scheduled a meeting for the 24th of April.

The subject of By-Laws should have come up in the last City Council meeting. This could push for passing on the 17th of April.

The subject of local artist inventory came up and is not proceeding well. It was decided that the local artist committee in the Steering Committee will take care of this.

There is a workshop in Glenwood Springs Sunday, May 19, that is organized by the State, geared toward funding financially. It emphasizes long term financial stability instead of short term crisis funding. There is a \$10.00 registration fee.

The next scheduled meeting for the Commission is not until May the 8th, 1991. It will be at 7:30 in the City Hall.
