MINUTES FOR THE GRAND JUNCTION COMMISSION OF ARTS AND CULTURE WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 8, 1992 - 7:00PM

First on the agenda was to review the proposals and resumes from potential consultants. Interviews were to begin at 7:15. The first person scheduled was Dennis Woodrich but he withdrew so the Commission moved on to other business.

1. Allison Sarmo passed out the new revised By-Laws for the Commission, approved by the City Council.

2. Work on the promotion video is on hold due to the cameras are not in yet.

3. Elections were held for the offices of Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Secretary. Larry Mazzeno nominated Allison Sarmo for Chairperson and all seconded it, making Allison Chairperson by unanimous vote.
