

MINUTES TO THE DECEMBER 9, 1992 MEETING OF THE COMMISSION ON ARTS AND CULTURE

The November meeting was informal due to a lack of quorum. Minutes were not taken.

AGENDA I: Review of final draft of Cultural Facilities Feasibility Study - presentation to City Council at Dec. 14th workshop.

 It was recommended by the Commission that the following be done: Priority 1 - The Art Center move downtown (with purchase of the Mesa Theatre) and the purchase of the Avolon

Priority 2 - Museum move

Both feasibility studies will be attached to provide more information to the City.

AGENDA II: Renewal of membership to NALAA and CCCAC for 1993? Should we join the Chamber of Commerce?

- Sanders moved that the Commission renew their membership to both NALAA and CCCAC. Schroeder-Wright seconded it and all were favor. Allison Sarmo was to check with the city to see if the Commission was already considered a member of the Chamber.

AGENDA III: Artists' Workshops to be done in 1993.

Mike Smedley reported on the feedback from the October Workshop neld at the Art Center. The majority of participants at this meeting represented the visual arts so plans for future workshops were basically centered around the visual arts.
Estimated costs for these workshops are \$2000, with an estimated income of \$1930, thus actually costing \$70 if figures are correct. Allison moved to approve preliminary

budget for workshops and grant writing. Ann seconded and all approved.

AGENDA IV: Follow-up on ideas from Nov. 21st roundtable meeting.

- Mike Smedley motioned that the Commission offer to support the development & implementation of an Arts Marketing Council for up to \$800 as per the Commission's 1993 budget. Ann seconded and all approved.

AGENDA V: Review of budget for 1993 and proposed projects. - Did not discuss due to lack of members at meeting.
