MINUTES FOR GRAND JUNCTION COMMISSION ON ARTS AND CULTURE

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 13, 1993

AGENDA I: Review budget and projects for 1993.

-An amount of \$3000 was carried over from 1992 budget to be used in 1993 along with an Avalon match fund grant of \$1000. -It was discussed that a laser printer would be purchased for \$500. Sanders motioned the proposal, Schroeder-Wright seconded and all approved.

AGENDA II: Discuss presentation to City Council Quality of Life Committee re funding package for Avalon Theater/Art Center/Mesa Theater project as per facilities study--to be presented January 18, 1993 at 2:00pm. (Study adopted by City Council 12/16/92 with minor amendment--change the word "fund" on first line page 62 to "participate in").

-The package was discussed and all were in favor. All members of the Commission were encouraged to attend the workshop. AGENDA III: Correspondence and other--Arts Marketing Council meeting scheduled for Wednesday, January 27, in Kiva Room of the Mesa County Public Library, at 7:00pm as per idea from November roundtable metting of all arts organizations. -It was discussed and a goal of getting at least two representatives from each organization to attend.

-Election of officers will be delayed until Commission is fully staffed. Crumbaker moved the motion, Buss seconded, all approved but Sarmo. It was passed.

-Smedley moved that the Commission will reconstitute a new Criteria Committee at the next meeting. Crumbaker seconded and all approved.

-Crumbaker moved that the Art on the Corner be nominated for the Governors Award for Excellence in the Art. Buss seconded and all approved. Meeting was adjourned.
