RE: Stoker Stadium – Track Resurfacing IFB-4746-20-DH

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

1. Q. We respectfully submit for your consideration a request to approve products as an accepted substitute on Stoker Stadium - Track Resurfacing for Plexitrac Accelerator.

A. The City shall **not** accept the Plexitrac Accelerator as an approved equal for the following of the specification documents submitted for consideration:

-its standard specification for thickness requirements seem to have inconsistencies in some of the specification documents, as where some thicknesses stated do not meet the thickness requirements/specifications as stated in the solicitation documents.

-The following items are unclear as to what is being proposed, and how the specifications are defined: 1) What is coefficient of friction vs. friction?

2) Tensile strength, what specifically is it pertaining to within the track surface product and or application?

However, if the thickness specification, and other specification items listed above can be met/applied, and defined as to make a proper comparison, then the City will consider it. Contractor must provide written documentation as to the specifications it intends to submit for approval, prior to the Inquiry Deadline as stated in the solicitation documents.

2. The City would also like to include a separate Add/Alternate line item for a track cover to protect the track surface from damage from football players with cleats crossing the track from locker rooms. Bidders shall utilize the attached updated Price Bid Schedule. Bidders shall also include specification documents for proposed track cover system. City reserves the right to award this Add/Alternate item base upon what is deemed the best track cover option for use at Stoker Stadium. Do not include the Add/Alternate pricing in the Base Bid pricing.

3. Q. I am resubmitting our track substitution request for the BSS 1000 with our epiQ Z5000 track.

A. The City shall accept the epiQ Z5000 as an approved equal.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
