***SYMPTOMS = CHILLS AND/OR FEVER GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO 100.4° F • COUGH • CONGESTION • RUNNY NOSE • SHORTNESS OF BREATH • DIFFICULTY BREATHING • FATIGUE • MUSCLE OR BODY ACHE • HEADACHE • SORE THROAT • NAUSEA AND/OR VOMITING • DIARRHEA • NEW LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL.**

DIRECT EXPOSURE = CLOSE CONTACT WITH A CONFIRMED OR SUSPECTED COVID-19 CASE WITHOUT THE USE OF PROPER PPE.

A SUSPECTED COVID-19 CASE = A DISPLAY OF SYMPTOMS WITHOUT A LABORATORY TEST.

****PROPER PPE = DISPOSABLE EXAMINATION GLOVES • DISPOSABLE ISOLATION GOWN OR SINGLE-USE/DISPOSABLE COVERALLS • N-95 OR HIGHER-LEVEL RESPIRATOR OR FACE MASK • EYE PROTECTION (GOGGLES OR FACE SHIELD).**

IF YOU HAVE TROUBLE BREATHING, PERSISTENT PAIN OR PRESSURE IN THE CHEST, NEW CONFUSION, INABILITY TO WAKE OR STAY AWAKE OR BLUISH LIPS OR FACE SEEK MEDICAL CARE IMMEDIATELY

*****VACCINATED (HAVE BEEN BOOSTED -OR- COMPLETED PRIMARY SERIES OF PFIZER OR MODERNA WITHIN LAST 6 MONTHS -OR- COMPLETED PRIMARY SERIES OF J&J VACCINE WITHIN THE LAST 2 MONTHS)**
