Proclamation

Whereas, trees are an important natural resource asset to the City of Grand Junction, State of Colorado, providing cooling shade, filtering air pollution, improving water quality, shielding properties from storms, and providing oxygen for the air we breathe; and

Whereas, trees increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and enhance the beauty of the City of Grand Junction, State of Colorado, with various forms, textures and colors; and

Whereas, all citizens of Grand Junction, now and in the future, will benefit from the planting of trees and the current canopy of over 37,000 public trees is essential infrastructure; and

Whereas, the State of Colorado has officially declared the 17th day of April as Arbor Day; and

the City of Grand Junction has officially declared the 25th day of April as Arbor Day and the City will be celebrating with the distributions of tree seedlings to residents who pledge to care for the trees;

the City of Grand Junction has been recognized as a Tree City USA for thirty-seven consecutive years by The National Arbor Day Foundation and desires to continue its tree-planting ways.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rick Taggert, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim April 25, 2020 as

"Arbor Day"

in the City of Grand Junction and encourage all citizens to support our City's Urban Forestry Program and to participate in this effort by planting a tree for a better future.
