The meeting via conference call was called to order at 1:59 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver and Deputy City Clerk Janet Harrell.

Hearing Officer Starritt noted the first survey did not include any residential signatures and on March 18, 2020 he directed the applicant to survey the Paradise Valley Mobile Home Park. Due to COVID-19 Hearing Officer Starritt amended the Local Authority's findings and permitted the City Clerk's office to conduct a "needs and desires" survey by mail to 50 random residents within the Paradise Valley Mobile Home Park.

Ms. Harrell read the results of the first and second survey (attached). Bananas Fun Park Manager Brian Limper answered questions regarding the location, how and where the alcohol will be served and who will be responsible for serving.

Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone was present to speak against the application. There was no one. He said based on the information presented, the needs and desires of the neighborhood are not being met and approved the license with the following conditions: 1) all customers 21 and over must be wrist banded, 2) no alcohol is to be allowed in outdoor game areas except for mini golf and 3) alcohol responsibility training certificates must be submitted to the City Clerk's office for all employees within six months from a State approved alcohol server responsibility class.

The City Clerk's Office will prepare a resolution of findings for Hearing Officer Starritt's signature.

A liquor license application permitting sales of malt and vinous beverages for consumption at place where sold, was filed with the Local Licensing Authority on February 4, 2020.

At the March 18, 2020 Liquor and Beer Meeting, the Licensing Authority of Grand Junction (Authority) requested the applicant survey the Paradise Valley Mobile Home Park located at 585 25 ½ Road. This location was included in the original survey's defined neighborhood (Patterson Road on the north, Riverside Parkway on the south, 25 ½ Road on the east, and 24 Road on the west, and includes both sides of the outer boundary streets), but was not covered by the applicant. Due to the COVID-19 virus and State of Colorado Executive Orders the Authority amended its policies to permit "needs and desires" surveying by mail. Therefore, the second survey was mailed to 50 randomly selected residents in the Paradise Valley Mobile Home Park to address the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood. The results below and on the attached map include responses from both surveys. One residential response was received from the second survey:
