Item 3: Arbor Day 2018

- Master Gardener and tree climbing will be from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Randy Coleman will receive the tree's April 9th and seedlings will be picked up by forestry staff in Fort Collins the week of April 16th.
- Discussed having citizens place a tag and \$2 for larger trees in a bucket (1 tag per tree per family).

Item 4: Forestry Update

- Vince Urbina and Tom Ziola both have trees/plaques that need to be installed. Need to speak with them about what location, possibly Lincoln Park during SWAF.
- Randy Coleman will get with Wanda W. in the City Clerk's office to check on the status of Vince Urbina joining the board.
- The SW corner at Hawthorne Park where the trees were removed, it has been discussed that we should use that open space for soccer/football practice field rather than replanting. Hoping that it would bring more families to the park. Will mulch around the remaining trees and separate irrigation for trees vs grass.
- Water quality can be an issue for trees.
- Shirley Nilsen will be managing 3-4 volunteers to assist downtown with weeding, planting, etc.
- Put together a training class with Tamarisk Coalition, BLM, Master Gardeners, etc. to meet with Real Estate Agents either June 7&8th or 14&15th. Discuss "The value of trees", refine what our message is.
- Kamie Long will check into rules on the "grant" that the Board was approved for. Maybe have the Board start a 5013C and open an account to put the grant funds in (Kamie will speak with Coloramo Credit Union and Randy will speak with the City).

Item 5: New Business

- Need to form a committee and sub-committee for the grant to decide whether we will use a professional or a student and put our thoughts together on what our goals are and put it out to bid. Refine what webpage will consist of.
