Item 4: Forestry Update

- Rotary Club tree planting scheduled for June 22<sup>nd</sup> at Canyon View Park. Start time set for 7 AM. The goal is for the most of the "work" to be done prior to the public arriving.
- There will be an area around 8 feet of the tree to be amended. Considering the use of Doug Jones product.
- Rotary trees will be planted in an underutilized area of Canyon View Park.
- The goal is for the area to become a nature area with the focus on trees.
- Current irrigation at the park will allow for adequate watering.
- Trees will be in 15 to 20 gallon containers.
- No press release issued for the Rotary plantings.
- The Rotary trees will help connect trails to the wash beginning at the playground.
- Dedications for the Rotary trees can take place at a later date.
- Max Cray, Rotary member, donated \$5000 for the plantings.
- The planting coincides with Rotary's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration.
- Code Enforcement inspecting tree trimmer licensing. Contact Weed Abatement Desk at 970-244-1583 to report concerns about possible non-licensed trimmers. Emily (Weed Abatement Program), has begun license inspections, however she is new to the process.
- In 2021, the City of Grand Junction will require Arborist certification.

- Arbor Day planning discussion should begin in the winter.
