

RESOLUTION NO. 09-20

DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE BY THE GLORIOUS FIG UNDER THE TRADE NAME OF THE GLORIOUS FIG, LOCATED AT 209 ½ COLORADO AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

A public hearing was held on September 16, 2020 by the Local Licensing Authority for the City of Grand Junction (hereinafter "City"), on the application submitted by THE GLORIOUS FIG (hereinafter "Applicant") for a Tavern license under the trade name of "The Glorious Fig" located at 209 ½ Colorado Avenue, Grand Junction, Colorado. The Local Licensing Authority having duly considered the evidence adduced at said hearing FINDS:

1. The hearing on September 16, 2020, on the application was held after proper notice thereof, as required by 44-3-311 C.R.S., et. seq.
2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the City Clerk's Office revealed that 7 persons were in support of the license being issued, 0 opposed.
3. There are 42 liquor licensed outlets in the surveyed area.
4. There were no counter petitions and no letters of opposition filed in regard to this application.
5. The moral character and reputation of the applicant for this application is good as determined by a check performed by the Grand Junction Police Department.

In light of all the evidence presented at the hearing, the documents and survey placed in the file, and the statements from the applicant, it is determined that the statutory requirements for the issuance of the liquor license have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION;


