The Downtown Christmas Tree was lit on Monday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. On November 20<sup>th</sup>, the City of Grand Junction Parks and Recreation will turn on the holiday lights throughout Downtown.

Dave stated that Downtown Grand Junction will partner with Townsquare Media for a Small Business Saturday promotion. There will be an opportunity for eighteen Downtown businesses to receive airtime to talk about specials, promotions, etc. This promotion is on a first come, first serve basis. Small Business Saturday is November 28<sup>th</sup>.
