TYPES OF MEMORIAL PROGRAMS

Memorial Tree Planting Program

This program provides trees as a Living Tribute for many generations. If you choose to take advantage of this service, a representative from the Forestry Division will contact you to finalize tree selection, location, and installation date.

PLEASE NOTE: Tree planting is focused towards a spring season (April through May) and fall season (September through October), and it takes approximately four weeks to have wood engraved maps created.

Option 1: City Park Memorial Tree

A personalized wood engraved map with the location of the tree will be provided to the purchaser to capture the location of the tree, and each tree will be added into the City's inventory data base. Stone markers placed at the base of a tree is an option within Orchard Mesa Memorial Forest only.

Option 2: Orchard Mesa Cemetery Memorial Forest

Includes name and dates engraved in a memorial wall, as well as options for an engraved memorial stone placed in the ground at the base of a tree. Trees are planted in the Memorial Forest at the Orchard Mesa Cemetery.

Memorial Bench and Shelter Program

Memorial benches and shelters have become a popular way to remember and pay tribute to loved ones. A representative from the Parks Division will be in contact with you to finalize park location, and installation date. It takes approximately six weeks for the items and plaque to be ordered and delivered.

An aluminum plaque with a personalized engraving will be placed near your memorial bench or shelter. You may request any City park, however restrictions may apply.
