Hearing Officer Starritt read the applications into the record recognizing they were the same applicants for different stores. Kevin Coates, Attorney for the applicant and Dennis Dirkse, Vice President of Retail Operation represented the applicant. They explained that CF Altitude, LLC had purchased 75 Colorado locations from Pester Marketing, LLC and have a Master File with the State of Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division. Most staff is remaining the same through the purchase.

Hearing Officer Starritt asked Ms. Sandoval if the files were in order. Ms. Sandoval said they were, with the exception of missing Wholesaler Affidavits. Mr. Coates explained these should be submitted within the week. Hearing Officer Starritt asked if there was anyone present to speak against the applications. There was no one. The applications for transfer of ownership 1 – 6 were approved conditionally upon receiving the Wholesaler Affidavits.

Hearing Officer Starritt stipulated to Mr. Schrock the approval was conditional upon the rules of Mesa County Health Department rules regarding COVID-19 being followed. The application for a special event permit submitted by Grand Junction Lodge #270 Loyal Order of Moose for "Raptors Poker 2 - 2021" was in order and approved.
