**RE:** 2021 Load and Haul Residual Radioactive Material IFB-4925-21-KH

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

1. Q. Does the DOE training have to be done if we have done it in the past?  
A. Yes, there are constant changes made to the policies and training. The GERT, Driver Briefing, RWP, vehicle survey/inspection etc. are required and will be done on-site and should only take 2-3 hours.
2. Q. Will an unrestricted release be required on the loader at the City clarifiers?  
A. No, unrestricted release will be required based on DOE standards. However, CDPHE will check the loading site daily to ensure that cleanup activities have occurred.
3. Q. What wrapping is needed/required for the trucks?  
A. Truck wrapping and other truck requirements can be found in 3.3.3 of the solicitation document.
4. Q. How are the readings for the material in the clarifier?  
A. The RRM in the clarifier meets the maximum 5mrem/ hour acceptance criterion stated in 3.3.2. of the solicitation document.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
