## ADDENDUM NO. 1

## RE: Monument Road Left Turn Lane at Frog Pond Subdivision IFB-4945-21-DH

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

- 1. Q. Item/line 17 on the bid schedule is referencing a traffic control code, however the description is stormwater management. Was the owner planning on have flagging paid for in a stand alone item? Stormwater management is generally a 208 item code.
  - A. Flagging for Traffic Control shall be included in the Traffic Control item #18. Contractors are directed to reference Section 208 of CDOT's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction for the Stormwater Management requirements. It is anticipated that due to the minimal disturbance during construction, a Stormwater Construction Permit will not be required.
- 2. Q. Since the bike path was installed within the last couple of years will the contractor be able to utilize the existing base course under the concrete?
  - A. Yes, the native base course material currently under the existing trail may be utilized to reconstruct the concrete trail. The Contractor will need to recompact any disturbed material to City Standards and re-establish aggregate shoulders to existing conditions.
- 3. Q. SP-2 Section 304 references the should as a 12:1 with a max width of 4 feet. If we are installing a 5 ½" mat should that to a 5.5' max width?
  - A. Special Provision SP-2 Section 304 on page 26 of the Solicitation shall be deleted. The Contractor shall follow the grading shown in the staking plans and sections in the Construction Drawings.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
