GRANT OF MULTIPURPOSE EASEMENT

A certain parcel of land lying in the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 2 West of the Ute Principal Meridian, being a portion of Lot 14, Valley West Filing No. Two, as same is recorded in Plat Book 12, Pages 166 and 167, Public Records of Mesa County, Colorado and being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the Southwest Corner of said Lot 14, Valley West Filing No. Two and assuming the West line of said Lot 14 bears N 19°25′33″ W and all other bearings contained herein are relative thereto; thence from said Point of Commencement, N 19°25′33″ W along the West line of said Lot 14 a distance of 106.28 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence from said Point of Beginning, N 19°25′33″ W along the West line of said Lot 14, a distance of 22.16 feet to a point being the beginning of a 340.0 foot radius curve, concave North, whose long chord bears S 88°04′06″ E a distance of 58.72 feet; thence Easterly along the arc of said curve, through a central angle of 09°54′27″ a distance of 58.79 feet to a point on the North line of that certain 100 foot wide parcel of land described in Book 230, Page 11, Public Records of Mesa County, Colorado; thence S 49°55′29″ W along said North line, a distance of 31.71 feet to a point being the beginning of a 360.0 foot radius curve, concave North, whose long chord bears N 86°50′04″ W a distance of 27.09 feet; thence Westerly along the arc of said curve, through a central angle of 04°18′45″ a distance of 27.10 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning.

Grantor reserves the right to use and occupy the real property burdened by this Easement for any lawful purpose which is not inconsistent with and which will not substantially interfere with the full use and quiet enjoyment of the rights herein granted; provided, however, that Grantor hereby covenants with Grantee that the Easement shall not be burdened or overburdened by the installation, construction or placement of any improvements, structures or fixtures thereon which may be detrimental to the facilities of Grantee or which may act to prevent reasonable ingress and egress for workers and equipment on, along, over, under, through and across the Easement.
