- **Whereas**, about every two and a half minutes, a person in the U.S. is diagnosed with lung cancer; and
- **Whereas**, lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths for women and men; and
- **Whereas**, Lung cancer screening saves lives, and advocacy and increased awareness will result in more high-risk individuals getting screened; and
- **Whereas**, public support for research funding will result in new treatments and better methods of early detection; and

Whereas, LUNG FORCE is a national initiative to defeat lung cancer, led by the American Lung Association, utilizing the color turquoise to signify air, breathing, and healthy lungs.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.B. McDaniel, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim the second week in May 2022 as

"Turquoise Takeover Week"

in the City of Grand Junction and encourages all residents to learn more about lung cancer, risk factors and early detection.
