- Whereas,** volunteerism is one of the factors that makes Grand Junction and the rest of the Grand Valley such a wonderful place to live and work.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anna Stout, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim April 2023 as
