Survey Participation and Format

- The survey was open for three weeks (3/20 through 4/7)
- Final survey participation reached 68% (508 responses)
- The survey consisted of 24 questions
 - 20 rated responses on 1-5 scale (Strongly Disagree Strongly Agree)
 - 3 multiple selection
 - 1 open ended response




What obstacles, if any, have you encountered when trying to be successful in your job?
