Feedback on Alternative Routes

- HWY 6 is not preferred by CDOT nor Palisade
- Palisade prefers Canal Route Existing Road goes into Highschool and Coupled with Taylor elementary.
- ORF's goals is to stay away from highways
- Mesa County: Revisit the "close to the river" alternative? It's been a couple of years since we approached property owners about this.
- Palisade: How important is connecting to the schools? Can we go south through Orchard Mesa?
 - Yes, has been looked at, expensive alternative, also misses the connection with the schools / clifton
- Palisade: Rideability detached sidewalk if along Hwy 6
- Bridge across ditch behind Palisade Highschool District owned, evacuation only. Needs to be replaced. Does D51 have an agreement

How to run the planning process

- Take Meeting Minutes send out to group (going to be turnover)
- Get a vision and preliminary design together and pick away at the details.
- \$105k ish for the study. Focus on alternatives and drill into details to ensure that preferred alternative is viable. May not get much of a design.
- What can the partners do to reduce work of consultant?
 - For example chasing down specific agreements like between school district and canal?
- Rather than looking at all the possibilities, focus the consultant on 2-3 alts.
