

GRAND JUNCTION LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY
MINUTES
June 21, 2023

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam D. Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver and Deputy City Clerk Janet Harrell.

II. License Renewal Applications

Hearing Officer Starritt read renewals 1 – 8 into the record. Ms. Harrell verified the applications were in order, but that Tepanyaki Japanese Steak House and Sushi Bar (Tepanyaki) required a successful reinspection by the Mesa County Health Department (MCHD) to maintain their license. Tepanyaki representative Nathan Nguyen said they have corrected all issues for the reinspection. Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone was present to speak against the applications; there was no one. Renewals 1 – 7 were approved and the renewal for Tepanyaki was conditionally approved pending a successful reinspection by the MCHD.

Managing Member Ryan Dutch was present to explain the late filing. Hearing Officer Starritt found good cause for the late filing and approved the renewal.

Administrator Barbara Case and Cancer Patient Fundraiser representative Kim River were present and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security, and how it will be conducted lawfully. Hearing Officer Starritt verified with Ms. Harrell the application was in order and asked if there was anyone present to speak against the application. He entered Exhibits "A" and "B" (attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statute 44-5-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit; it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws. The application for the special event permit submitted by Loyal Order of Moose Grand Junction Lodge 270 for "Cancer Patient Fundraiser - 2023" was in order and approved.

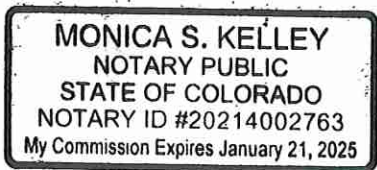

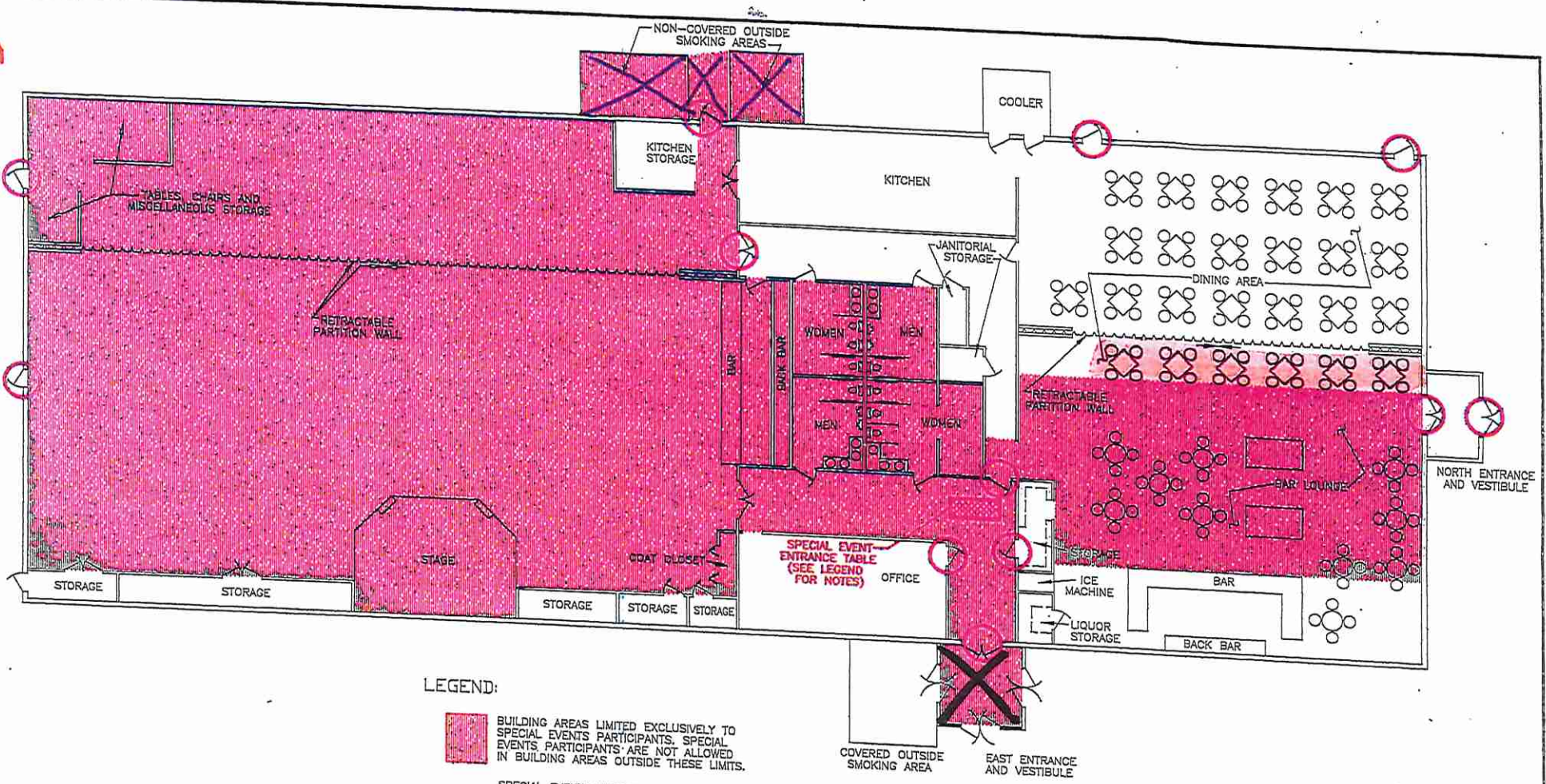

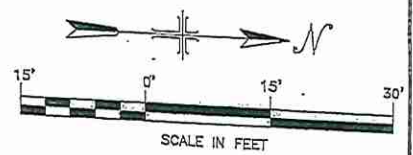
