RE: Shipping Container (Qty. 7) IFB-5297-23-KH

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

1. **Q:** In paragraph 3.1. General: It's requesting to deliver 7 new shipping containers, however in 3.2 Specifications: the request is different and is asking for 2 new and 5 used. Can you please specify the requirements?

A: Please ignore the language stating all seven containers must be new. Please look at the addendum one version of the price bid schedule.

2. **Q:** If your department is going to accept used containers, it's important to specify if the containers need to be Cargo Worthy or just Wind and Water Tight(WWT). There's a difference in pricing between these two containers since WWT containers are typically older units and a bit more beat up. Cargo Worthy usually have been in the fleet less years than WWT containers and can carry a heavier weight to them.

A: Please review addendum one version of price bid schedule for answer. Any that do not specify cargo worthy can be wind and water tight or better.

3. **Q:** Do you have a specific color these containers need to be?

A: The City does not care what color the containers are.

4. **Q:** Do the (2) 20 foot containers need to be standard height or are you requesting High Cubed as well?

A: Please refer to the updated specifications in question nine.

5. **Q:** Can you tell me if the Fire Training Center in Grand Junction can lift any of the containers off a flatbed? Or will you need roll off deliveries?

A: The delivery location can not lift the containers. They will be off loaded onto dirt/gravel.

6. **Q:** Also, is the delivery location paved and level?

A: The delivery location is not paved. It has dirt/gravel.

7. **Q:** Im not 100% clear on how you want offers submitted for this bid since it states that you can take one trip or multi trip. Should I submit two offers, one with only one trip pricing and the other with one trip + multi trip?

A: You may submit two responses.

8. **Q:** Does your site have offloading capabilities?

A: Please refer to the answer for question six.

9. **Specifications:** The City is requesting the following:

- Four (4) 40' High Cube Storage Containers (One Trip or Multi Trip)
- One (1) 20' Storage Container One Tripper (Preferably High Cube)
- One (1) 40' Storage Container One Tripper (**Cargo Worthy**) (High Cube or Standard)
- One (1) 20' Storage Container One Tripper (**Cargo Worthy**) (High Cube or Standard)

10. Firm shall utilize the addendum 1 version of the price bid schedule attached for their bid.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
