#### MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 7, 2013, 2:00 P.M.

#### **HEARING OFFICER MICHAEL GRATTAN**

### I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting convened at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Mike Grattan, City Attorney John Shaver, and Deputy City Clerk Juanita Peterson.

#### II. APPLICATIONS TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

 El Tapatio, LLC dba El Tapatio, 1145 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Hotel and Restaurant – Continued from July 17, 2013 – Telephone Conference with LanguageLine

The applicant did bring their own interpreter so it was agreed to not use LanguageLine at this time.

Francisco and Claudia Espinoza, owners, were both present. They brought Ms. Erica Jaramillo as their interpreter. Hearing Officer Grattan asked Ms. Jaramillo to translate to them if they are in agreement, to use Ms. Jaramillo instead of the LanguageLine. They were in agreement.

Ms. Peterson said the continuance was due to the licensee not disclosing the violation in the previous year. Mr. Espinoza has now submitted a letter regarding the sale of alcohol to an underage person on July 11, 2012 (see attached). Ms. Peterson said at the July 17<sup>th</sup> hearing there were outstanding issues with the Health Department. The representatives from the Health Department are here today and the licensee is still not in compliance. Ms. Jaramillo then translated to them what Ms. Peterson reported.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked who wrote this letter since it was in English. Ms. Jaramillo translated that to Mr. Espinoza. He responded that he had a translator that he dictated what he wanted to say in the letter.

City Attorney Shaver asked if they understand and agree what was written in the letter which was translated back to them. They answered yes. City Attorney Shaver also asked if they understand the State and City laws regarding this violation. Again this was translated and they responded affirmatively.

Ms. Jaramillo translated that this is the reason the establishment had their employees all attend the meeting with the Health Department.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked if there was anything else Mr. Espinoza wanted to say in regard to the violation or the letter. He responded no as far as the letter goes, but they are trying to work with their employees and the Health Department and they are not getting a response from the Health Department.

Marcela Lucas and Heather Nara with the Health Department came forward and gave an update since the last hearing that they had nine critical violations. They conducted a special food handler's class for the licensee and had 32 employees attend. Then the Health Department conducted the follow-up with still four critical violations and these have been repetitive. There has been a letter of notification of non-compliance issued on August 3, 2013 to the establishment (Exhibit A) regarding civil penalties that has been started.

City Attorney Shaver asked what the steps were regarding the violation. Ms. Lucas responded that if they are in non-compliance they receive another letter and they are scheduled to inspect today, on August 7<sup>th</sup>. If they are still not in compliance they will be issued a fine. They hope they will have a follow-up of compliance before the next hearing of August 21, 2013.

Hearing Officer Grattan said to Ms. Jaramillo that he seen her relating all of this information to the Espinoza's, she answered affirmatively and that they understood. Hearing Officer Grattan said the Health Department is asking for additional continuance with the hope of compliance before that time. He asked if that was acceptable to the Espinoza's. All agreed with this. If this compliance takes place, the Health Department will need to only issue a letter and the Espinoza's will not be required to appear.

The renewal was continued to August 21, 2013.

 Bocaza Western Slope LLC dba Bocaza Mexican Grille, 644 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Hotel and Restaurant – Continued from July 17, 2013

No one was present representing the applicant.

The application for renewal for Bocaza Western Slope LLC dba Bocaza Mexican Grille was in compliance with the Health Department and was found to be in order and approved.

3. Junction Liquors LLC dba Fun Junction Liquors, 510 28 ¾ Road, Unit 202, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Retail Liquor Store

Cody Snider, Owner, was present. Ms. Peterson read into the record a letter submitted by the applicant regarding a violation it received from the State for sale to an underage person in March 2013 (see attached).

Hearing Officer Grattan found the renewal for Junction Liquors LLC dba Fun Junction Liquors to be in order and approved.

4. Outback Steakhouse of Florida, LLC dba Outback Steakhouse #0621, 2432 Hwy. 6 & 50, Grand Junction, CO 81505, Hotel and Restaurant

No one was present representing the applicant. Ms. Peterson reported the inspections are in compliance except for the Health Department and they are asking for a conditional approval until they can re-inspect.

Hearing Officer Grattan approved the renewal conditionally that they come into compliance with the Health Department.

5. Black Dog Grills, LLC dba Genghis Grill, 2474-C Hwy 6 & 50, Grand Junction, CO 81505, Hotel and Restaurant

No one was present representing the applicant.

The application for renewal for Black Dog Grills, LLC dba Genghis Grill was found to be in order and approved.

6. Texas Roadhouse of Grand Junction, LLC dba Texas Roadhouse, 2870 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Hotel and Restaurant

No one was present representing the applicant.

The application for renewal for Texas Roadhouse of Grand Junction, LLC dba Texas Roadhouse was found to be in order and approved.

7. JJ's Cruisers, LLC dba Cruisers, 715 Horizon Drive, Suite 100, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Tavern

Mr. Jude Morkus, General Manager, was present.

Ms. Peterson reported that the paperwork is in order but the local background on Mr. Morkus showed a citation issued for possession of marijuana. Mr. Morkus submitted a letter which Ms. Peterson read into the record regarding this issue (see attached).

Hearing Officer Grattan and City Attorney Shaver did not have anything additional to ask Mr. Morkus and Hearing Officer Grattan approved the renewal.

8. Dillon Companies, Inc. dba City Market #1, 2770 Hwy 50 South and City Market #32, 200 Rood Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, 3.2% Beer Retail (Off Premises)

No one was present representing the applicant.

The applications for Dillon Companies Inc. dba City Market #1 and #32 were found to be in order and approved.

9. Orange Coast Investment, Inc. dba Grand Vista Hotel, 2790 Crossroads Blvd., Grand Junction, CO 81506, Hotel and Restaurant

Debra Revis, Manager, was present.

The application for Orange Coast Investment Inc. dba Grand Vista Hotel was found to be in order and approved.

 Erich and Connie LLC dba Rocky Mountain Pub, 539 Colorado Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Tavern

Ms. Connie Frei, owner, was present. Ms. Peterson reported the paperwork is in order and Ms. Frei has taken back the responsibility as the Operating Manager due to a staff change. Ms. Peterson reported the fire, health, and sales tax reports are in compliance. Police Officer Keech is present to address the numerous calls related to this establishment.

Hearing Officer Grattan said due to the violent nature of the incident this week, this has been a problem establishment even before Ms. Frei was the owner. He asked if anyone had an objection to moving it to the end of the agenda.

Everyone present regarding this renewal agreed.

#### III. APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT

 Mesa Developmental Services dba Strive, 950 Grand Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous, for Calabash Festival on September 6, 2013 from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at 641 Struthers Avenue in the Amphitheater at Western Colorado Botanical Gardens.

Officer: Jeff Nichols, 678 Tahoe Circle, Grand Junction, CO 81506 Event Manager: Robert Haywood, 554 Garfield #7, Grand Junction, CO 81504

Mr. Robert Haywood, Event Manager, was present.

Ms. Peterson said the paperwork is order and the reports are in compliance. City Attorney Shaver presented Exhibit A and B for Mr. Haywood to examine. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Haywood if he had knowledge of the two documents given to him. Mr. Haywood said he did not; he has only taken over on August 1, 2013 for this event.

Hearing Officer Grattan said there is time to continue this item until the August 21, 2013 hearing to give Mr. Haywood an opportunity to become familiar with these items or if he wanted to make a call and have Jeff Nichols who signed the questionnaire come to the hearing, as the hearing will be still in session for a while yet.

Mr. Haywood said Mr. Nichols would not be available so to continue to the meeting of August 21, 2013 would work. Ms. Peterson said the premise would

need to be re-posted with a Notice and the City Clerk's office would have that ready this week as it will need to be posted Sunday, August 11, 2013.

2. City of Grand Junction – Parks and Recreation Department, 1340 Gunnison Avenue, Malt, Vinous, Spirituous, for the Colorado Pork and Hops Challenge on September 13, 2013 from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and September 14, 2013 from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Director: Robert Schoeber, 2598 Kayden Ct., Grand Junction, CO 81505 Event Manager: Larry Manchester, 2287 Vista Rio Ct., Grand Junction, CO 81507

Mr. Larry Manchester, Event Manager, was present.

Ms. Peterson said the paperwork was in order. City Attorney Shaver handed Mr. Manchester two Exhibits marked A and B (see attached) and asked Mr. Manchester to describe the event and asked if that was his signature on the questionnaire. Mr. Manchester said it was and said this is an event that draws professional bar-b-ques teams from across the nation.

City Attorney Shaver then asked Mr. Manchester to describe Exhibit B and the areas outlined on the map. Mr. Manchester said there would be two sections, one for the BBQ teams and one for the main festival which would have the beer area. City Attorney Shaver asked about the security. Mr. Manchester described the same security they have had in the past and that they would even have security overnight.

Hearing Officer Grattan admitted Exhibits A and B into the record and found that under Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there is no evidence that the issuance of the permit would be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws. He found that the application for a special events permit submitted by City of Grand Junction for the Pork and Hops Challenge for 2013 was approved.

3. Grand Junction Lodge No. 270, Loyal Order of Moose, 567 25 ½ Road, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous, for the Eusebia Garza Quinceanera on August 24, 2013 from 4:00 p.m. to 11:50 p.m. and the Joyce Serrano 40<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary on August 31, 2013 from 4:00 p.m. to 11:55 p.m.

#### Officer and

Event Manager: Dennis Tobin, 2676 H Road, Grand Junction, CO 81506

Hearing Officer Grattan stated that each application will be considered separately.

Ms. Peterson reported the paperwork was turned in complete and that Police Officer Dave Keech had submitted a report regarding the last event held at the Moose Lodge.

Officer Dave Keech said at the last event he noticed the wrist bands were not issued to patrons prior to his arrival but identification was checked and then wristbands were issued once he was on the scene. Mr. Tobin said this was not the regular security company they normally use. The wristbands were not issued until 7 p.m. when the alcohol was going to be served. The group was having a dinner prior to the event. Officer Keech provided a "best practices" session of how the patrons should be banded.

Regarding the application for the Eusebia Garza Quinceanera on August 24, 2013, City Attorney Shaver handed Mr. Tobin a couple of documents marked Exhibit A and B and asked him to describe for the Authority what the document marked Exhibit A was. Mr. Tobin explained that the document is a Questionnaire and Affidavit. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Tobin if he has personal knowledge of the information contained in the document and asked him to describe the nature of the document and what is contained in it. Mr. Tobin said that he completed the questionnaire and what a Quinceanera is. The Lodge has hosted others in the past. They expect to have 275 people in attendance. City Attorney Shaver asked if the event is to be held at 567 25 ½ Road and if that is Lodge 270, Loyal Order of Moose. Mr. Tobin said yes, it is.

City Attorney Shaver called Mr. Tobin's attention to the document marked Exhibit B and asked him to describe it to the Authority, specifically the area marked in red. Mr. Tobin said that the area marked in red is an 8,700 square foot ballroom with dance floor, bandstand, and bar adjacent to four bathrooms.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked Mr. Tobin if in these current Special Events they will have the normal security company they have used in the past. Mr. Tobin said yes, it is up to the renters of the hall to hire the security company.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Tobin if Lodge 270 has hosted any events in the past and have there been any problems. Mr. Tobin said he believes they have had eight this year and have had no problems.

City Attorney Shaver asked that the background for the witness be reflected in his testimony and no further questioning relative as to who he is or who he represents. Hearing Officer Grattan concurred and said that Exhibit B will also be reflected in the record because it is the same diagram for both events.

Regarding the Joyce Serrano 40<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary on August 31, 2013, City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Tobin to describe the event. City Attorney Shaver asked in order to expedite the process if there will be anything different than the information Mr. Tobin presented for the Quinceanera. Mr. Tobin said the age group is significantly different between the groups, this one being an older age group.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked about the difference in the number of participants being 200 on the questionnaire but Mr. Tobin indicated there will be 250. Mr. Tobin said these are just estimates.

Hearing Officer Grattan admitted both Exhibits A and one Exhibit B (see attached) into the record for both Special Events Permits and found that under Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there is no evidence that the issuance of the permits would be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special events, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws. He found that the applications for special events permits submitted by Grand Junction Lodge No. 270, Loyal Order of Moose for the Eusebia Garza Quinceanera and the Joyce Serrano 40<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary be approved.

4. Hilltop Health Services Corporation, 1331 Hermosa Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81506, Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous, for the Western Colorado Classic Auto Event, August 31 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and September 1, 2013 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Canyon View Park, 730 24 Road

Officer: Mike Stahl, 2599 Kayden Ct., Grand Junction, CO 81505 Event Manager: Sarah Catlin, 772 Castle Dr., Palisade, CO 81526

Mr. Bruce Schwenke, Director of Purchasing for Hilltop and a steering committee member for the event, was present. Mr. Schwenke said he would like to submit a new diagram of the area. City Attorney Shaver said he would mark this Exhibit C.

Ms. Peterson reported the paperwork was in order and all the reports were in compliance.

City Attorney Shaver gave Mr. Schwenke copies of all the Exhibits A, B, (see attached) and C. After Hearing Officer Grattan and City Attorney Shaver looked at Exhibit C, they determined that for the purpose of the Authority, Exhibit B is the best diagram to use. He asked Mr. Schwenke if he had personal knowledge of the event. Mr. Schwenke said he did, he has attended several meetings on the event and described the event that will take place.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Schwenke if he has personal knowledge of Exhibit A. He said that he did due to the various meetings he has attended on this committee. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Schwenke if he was an employee of Hilltop. Mr. Schwenke said yes. Mr. Schwenke said this is an inaugural event for this classic car show and gave a description of events to happen. He also gave a description how they will control the event, how they check identification, and training for their volunteers. Security will be by Grand Valley Security, even during the night. All exits will be manned by volunteers or security. The event will shut down and a final sweep will be at 4:30 p.m. Exhibit B was handed back to Mr. Schwenke and City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Schwenke to describe the red line on the diagram. Mr. Schwenke said this is the perimeter of the event and described the types of fencing they will be using.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Schwenke if alcohol will be served at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Schwenke asked another committee member, Ms. George Rossman to answer this question. Ms. Rossman said she will just be doing the ground work and yes, alcohol will be served from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Hearing Officer Grattan said the application indicated the hours being 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Ms. Rossman said they will be closing at 4:00 p.m. with a final sweep being at 4:30 p.m. Hearing Officer said he is inclined to extend this time by a  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour and amend the application. All were in agreement.

City Attorney Shaver asked either one if Hilltop has had an event like this in the past. Mr. Schwenke said no not to his knowledge. Ms. Rossman said she has worked other events for Hilltop but none where alcohol was served.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked City Attorney Shaver if he had any concerns. City Attorney Shaver said no.

Hearing Officer Grattan admitted Exhibits A and B into the record for the Special Events Permit (see attached) and found that under Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there is no evidence that the issuance of the permit would be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws and approved the Special Event Permit.

### IV. <u>APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN CORPORATE STRUCTURE</u>

1. Walterscheid Investment and Consulting Inc., dba All Pro Liquor, 2913 Patterson #4, Grand Junction, CO 81504

Add: Korine M. Walterscheid, 2312 I Road, Grand Junction, CO 81505 as Secretary/Director

No one was present representing the applicant. Ms. Peterson said that the local background was in compliance but CBI/FBI is still pending.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked if they were removing anyone. Ms. Peterson said no, just making an addition. Hearing Officer Grattan approved the change in corporate structure pending a clear CBI/FBI report.

#### V. <u>APPLICATION FOR NEW LICENSE – RESOLUTION, FINDINGS AND DECISION</u>

 Square 1 LLC dba The Point, 1230 North 12<sup>th</sup> Street, #2, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Beer and Wine

President: Tim Foster, 301 East Dakota Dr., Grand Junction, CO 81507

Mr. Craton Edwards identified himself as the manager at The Point along with Shawn Foster and John Nitti. Georgann Jouflas, Advisor of the Point was also present.

Ms. Peterson reported that the first step for this applicant was to take before the City Council a request to have the Municipal Code amended reducing the distance a beer and wine liquor licensed premise must be from the college. This was approved by Ordinance No. 4595 on July 17, 2013. She also reported the paperwork is in order and commended the students with the quality of paperwork submitted particularly since they had so many students involved.

All the reports are in compliance and the CBI/FBI paperwork was already returned and came back fine.

The applicant conducted a survey of the needs and desires of the neighborhood. Ms. Peterson then read the results into the record (see attached).

Hearing Officer Grattan asked exactly where this location is. Mr. Edwards said where the Yoshi Bowl was located across from the CMU campus. Hearing Officer Grattan asked exactly what this will be. Mr. Edwards said this is Ms. Jouflas's brain child. He characterized the establishment as a student business incubator; there was not a place on campus for this to happen. They want a beer and wine type atmosphere, a place where kids can come and study.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked if there was an incubator aspect to this. Mr. Edwards responded no, it is a side project, this is a for profit business.

City Attorney Shaver inquired regarding the survey. He asked the applicants to describe who conducted the survey. Mr. Edwards spoke for the students present that it was divided up into 6 groups. Each group got 10-15 surveys, the results were extremely positive. Mr. Edwards said that the class worked on the survey as a summer project and they (the class) compiled the survey results.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Edwards who the manager was as several indicated they were all managers.

Ms. Jouflas said that she is the manager of the LLC and these students will work under her supervision. Ms. Peterson said being a Beer and Wine application they did not have register a manager. Ms. Jouflas corrected her statement and said she is the manager of The Point not the LLC.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Edwards if they have knowledge of the information that was compiled for the survey and if they agree with the results Ms. Peterson read into the record. Mr. Edwards responded affirmatively. City Attorney Shaver asked if there was an attempt to go back to the areas where there was no one at home. Mr. Edwards said yes this was attempted. Mr. Edwards said they did have the students adjust their time of attempting to catch more people at home at different times.

City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Edwards if any of the businesses were competitors. Mr. Edwards said yes for food, but not sure about alcohol, he believed Kannah Creek was surveyed.

City Attorney Shaver asked about the residential respondents, if there was any in a concentrated or demographic area relative to those who favored the license. Mr. Edwards said no.

Hearing Officer Grattan said he still did not understand the structure. Ms. Jouflas said this group formed an LLC for the E Club (Entrepreneur Club). CMU is the member, and although she is designated as the manager of the LLC, CMU controls it. The students will be managers in terms of an internship in order, to learn to run a business. Hearing Officer Grattan asked who will be responsible for the liquor sales. Ms. Jouflas said she would be as the advisor. Hearing Officer Grattan asked if the students are all over 21 years of age. She said there are two under 21 right now, but they would not have any manager duties until they turned 21.

City Attorney Shaver asked if Ms. Jouflas will be on site or designate this to her managers. She said she will not be there 100% of the time and then it would be designated over to the student who is the designated manager at that time.

Ms. Jouflas added that the intention was to not be a bar but a late night food place, offering students food, music, art, not a "let's go get drunk and have a bar" establishment. It is a place students can learn a business.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked if there was anyone else who had anything to add. Officer Dave Keech said he had a couple of questions. He knows they have worked with Officer Richardson on the CMU campus, but is this open to just students or the public also. Ms. Jouflas answered both. He asked if they are allowing under 21 also? Ms. Jouflas replied yes, as it is a coffee shop along with food. Police Officer Keech's concern is the alcohol in possession of those under 21 years of age and asked then to describe how they were going to control that aspect of the business. Mr. Edwards said they will religiously continue to check ID's. When it does get busy they will put security at the door and wristband those over 21. Officer Keech wanted them to be aware that Kannah Creek closes early, like around 11 p.m., and once they realize The Point is there, patrons will be coming to their establishment. This might become a late night college bar. Mr. Edwards said this is also their concern too. Mr. Edwards said they will have the State Liquor Enforcement come down the first week they are open to help check ID's.

City Attorney Shaver said based upon the evidence presented he recommends approval. Hearing Officer Grattan said in his opinion they will have problems with underage persons. There being no opposition to this application present, he found the application for a new beer and wine liquor license submitted by Square 1 LLC dba The Point was in order and approved. The City Clerk's office will prepare a resolution for Hearing Officer Grattan's signature.

### VI. OTHER BUSINESS

Erich and Connie LLC dba Rocky Mountain Pub, 539 Colorado Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Tavern

Hearing Officer Grattan recalled Ms. Connie Frei to the podium. He said he is going to dispense with the normal format as all reports are in order. The only people present remaining in the room are Officer Keech, Ms. Frei, City Attorney Shaver, Deputy City Clerk Peterson, City Clerk Tuin, and Hearing Officer Grattan. A discussion on the current and past history of the establishment was given by Hearing Officer Grattan. He would like to just talk on the record to try and get this problem under control.

Ms. Frei stated she is going to get stricter with her bartenders, up the security and start coming in more in the evenings. She believes they are doing better. She doesn't know really what happened the other night even after watching the cameras.

Officer Keech said one of the main problems is the 500 block area downtown with a tight group of folks. All the troubles happening downtown are happening in that area. He is promoting security outside the door and stopping problems before they come into the bar. The other three establishments downtown are now doing that, and it has made a difference. With only 2 security guards and only one working at one time, the security needs to be inside. That is a problem. An establishment like this should have 2 to 3 working.

Ms. Frei said she cannot afford to hire 3 security guards with only 10 patrons. Officer Keech said he understands that issue.

Hearing Officer Grattan said the paper indicated that the ones involved were both highly intoxicated. Officer Keech said that was correct. Ms. Frei said they have both been banned from the establishment. Officer Keech said the two involved in the incident were both highly intoxicated, one was at the Rocky Mountain Pub and the other was not before the incident.

City Attorney Shaver gave a brief history of this establishment and penalties imposed by his Staff. Revocation and suspension are the next tools for his office to employ and the history matters.

Hearing Officer Grattan said that he understands this establishment has cleaned up a lot of the issues from the past.

Ms. Frei said she needs to start getting tougher with her employees.

Hearing Officer Grattan is not ready to revoke the license at this point but is looking at putting a very restricted review period on this licensee. City Attorney Shaver concurred. Ms. Frei is again the registered manager and has indicated she will be at the establishment more frequently an absentee owner or manager will not work for this establishment. Hearing Officer Grattan recommended a very short period of time before a review of this establishment. City Attorney Shaver would concur noting something has got to change.

#### NOTIFICATION OF NON-COMPLIANCE RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT

On June 27, 2013, Marcela Lucas of the Mesa County Health Department conducted an inspection of El Tapatio licensed by you, El Tapatio, LLC, at 1145 North Avenue in Grand Junction, CO. Nine critical violations were found to be in violation of the *Colorado Retail Food Establishment Rules and Regulations*. The violations were to be corrected by July 3, 2013.

A follow-up inspection was conducted on July 31, 2013 and four critical violations were still outstanding and are summarized below:

#### **VIOLATIONS**

- 2c Hands washed as needed (\*Section 2-403): Observed food handler wet fingers and then wipe hands dry rather than properly wash hands when required.
- 2d Hygenic practices (\*Section 2-501): Observed food employee wipe hands on apron.
- 2f- Demonstration of knowledge (\*Section 2-102): Food employees do not appear to understand basic food handling practices.
- 3e Cold hold food at 41°F or less (\*Section 3-501A) Potentially hazardous foods observed above 41°F.

Therefore, pursuant to sections 25-1-107, 25-1-109, 25-4-1610(c) and 25-4-1611 Colorado Revised Statutes 1998, you as the licensee are hereby ordered to correct the deficiencies set forth above as soon as possible but by no later than August 7, 2013, 8 am, so as to comply with the *Colorado Retail Food Establishment Rules and Regulations*. The applicable laws and regulations are enclosed for your information.

Any written statement or data concerning the deficiencies set forth above will be considered by the Department.

Failure to comply with the provisions of this Notification of Non-Compliance by continued or additional violations of rules and regulations within the category or categories of rules and regulations of which you are notified herein, will subject you, as licensee, to a civil penalty which may be assessed by the Department. The amount of the civil penalty would be no less than two hundred and fifty dollars and not more than five hundred dollars.

Fun Junction Liquors has the policy that employees are required to take TIPS as well as check ID's for all patrons. Due to these policies the employee that served the minor was terminated. The earliest TIPS class was held April 24<sup>th</sup>, in which all Fun Junction Liquor employees attended. We will continue to send our employees to these courses and more. Checking ID's has become a priority for our employees. We have also installed a clock that displays the minimum birth date and year a patron must be to be over the age of 21. We feel that we have taken the correct means of action, to prevent the service of minors in the future.




