RESOLUTION NO. 11-23

DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A HOTEL & RESTAURANT LICENSE BY SMILE HOT POT, LLC UNDER THE TRADE NAME OF SMILE HOT POT LOCATED AT 550 SOUTH AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

A public hearing was held on December 20, 2023 by the Liquor Licensing Authority for the City of Grand Junction (hereinafter "City"), on the application submitted by Smile Hot Pot, LLC (hereinafter "Applicant") for a Hotel & Restaurant license under the trade name of "Smile Hot Pot," located at 550 South Avenue, Grand Junction, Colorado. The Liquor Licensing Authority having duly considered the evidence adduced at said hearing FINDS:


1. The hearing on December 20, 2023, on the application was held after proper notice thereof, as required by 44-3-311 C.R.S., et. seq.
2. The survey of the neighborhood revealed that 39 residents and 56 businesses were in favor of the license being issued and no residents or businesses were opposed.
3. There are 31 liquor licensed outlets in the surveyed area.
4. There were no counter petitions and no letters of opposition filed regarding this application.
5. The moral character and reputation of the applicant for this application is good as determined by a check performed by the Grand Junction Police Department.

In light of all the evidence presented at the hearing, the documents and survey placed in the file, and the statements from the applicant, it is determined that the statutory requirements for the issuance of the liquor license have been met.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LIQUOR
LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION;**

That the application submitted by Smile Hot Pot, LLC for a Hotel & Restaurant license under the trade name of "Smile Hot Pot" located at 550 South Avenue, Grand Junction, Colorado, be approved.
