Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

1. **Q:** What color would the Buyer want the UTV to be?

A: The City does not care what color the UTV is.

2. **Q:** Line item 19-Snow Tracks: Do they want the tracks mounted on the UTV at time of delivery, or do you just want the Snow Track kits delivered with the unit for installation later as this unit would deliver in the Spring and presumably the snow would be gone until later in the Fall? We would not normally deliver a unit this time of year with the tracks installed, but wanted to check with you folks before we submit the bid. The installation of the tracks requires 4-hours of labor and would be a complete waste of money if they are just going to be removed after we make delivery.

A: The Snow tracks shall be shipped loose, and City Staff will mount them when needed.

3. **Q:** Will the utv be used at the Golf Courses?

A: No, this UTV will not be used at the Golf Courses. The City's intention is to utilize the track system to access the City watershed during times when snowpack is less than what would require a snow mobile to access.

4. **Q:** I ran into the Snow Tracks and was wondering if the City is wanting a True Commercial set of snow tracks or just any kit of tracks. Obviously, this can lead to a large difference in price.

A: Bidders are encouraged to quote a track system that they feel will deliver the best value for the price and that meets all the specifications.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
