

**GRAND JUNCTION LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY
MINUTES
July 3, 2024**

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam D. Starritt, (virtual) City Attorney John Shaver, City Clerk Selestina Sandoval and Deputy City Clerk Krystle Koehler.

II. License Renewal Applications

1. Orange Coast Investments, Inc. dba Grand Vista Hotel, 2790 Crossroads Blvd, Grand Junction, CO 81506, Hotel & Restaurant.
2. The Platinum Cleaver, LLC dba Pantuso's Ristorante, 755 Horizon Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81506, Hotel & Restaurant.

Hearing Officer Starritt read renewals 1 – 2 into the record and there was a correction to The Platinum Cleaver, LLC dba Pantuso's Ristorante address which the correct address is 421 Brach Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81507, Hearing Officer Starritt verified with Mrs. Koehler the applications were in order. Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone was present to speak against any of the applications; there was no one.

Renewals 1 – 2 were approved.

Development Director: Annie Lampard, 2015 North 6th Street, Grand Junction, CO 81501.

Development Director Annie Lampard was present and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security, and how it will be conducted lawfully. Hearing Officer Starritt verified with Mrs. Koehler the application was in order and asked if there was anyone present to speak against the application. There was no one. Hearing Officer Starritt entered Exhibits "A" and "B" (attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to the Colorado State Statue 44-05-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit; it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in past special events to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws. The application for the special event permit submitted by Western Slope Center for Children for “Sweet Swing Peaches and Baseball Extravaganza - 2024” was in order and approved.

2. Rotary Club of Grand Junction – Horizon Sunrise, P.O. Box 459, Grand Junction, CO 81502 “Beer Garden at Market On Main Events - 2024” – August 22, 2024, from 5:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. and September 26, 2024, from 5:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. located on Main Street between 3rd and 7th Street.

Event Manager: Miquette Gerber, 324 Dakota Dr, Grand Junction, CO 81507.

Event Manager Miquette Gerber was present and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security, and how it will be conducted lawfully. Hearing Officer Starritt verified with Mrs. Koehler the application was in order and asked if there was anyone present to speak against the application. There was no one. Hearing Officer Starritt entered Exhibits “A”, “B” “C” (attached) into the record.

Citadel Security, or another comparable company, will be hired for roaming about the entire area.

7. Describe the Security Control Plan (use additional sheet if necessary).
Every egress point will have signage noting that no alcohol is allowed beyond the physical barrier. - See attached.
At egress points nearest the pouring station at 4th and Main, at least 1 person will be there to not allow
ensure alcohol does not leave the boundary of the beer garden. Volunteers will be checking photo ID for those
those wishing to purchase alcohol. If they provide approved ID, they will be issued a wrist band prior to
being able to purchase alcohol.

8. How will security personnel be identified?
Hired security personnel will have shirts with "security" printed on them.

9. If this event is an outdoor event, how will the exterior boundaries of the premises be marked (i.e., roped, fenced, etc.)?
Pedestrian or other fencing will be used.

Valid State or Federal issued forms of identification will be requested from anyone who appears to be 55 years of age. Once a person is verified to be over 21 years of age, they will be issued a wrist band.

Shouting loud and/or slurred speech / Instead of/uneven gait and/or standing / In appropriate behavior

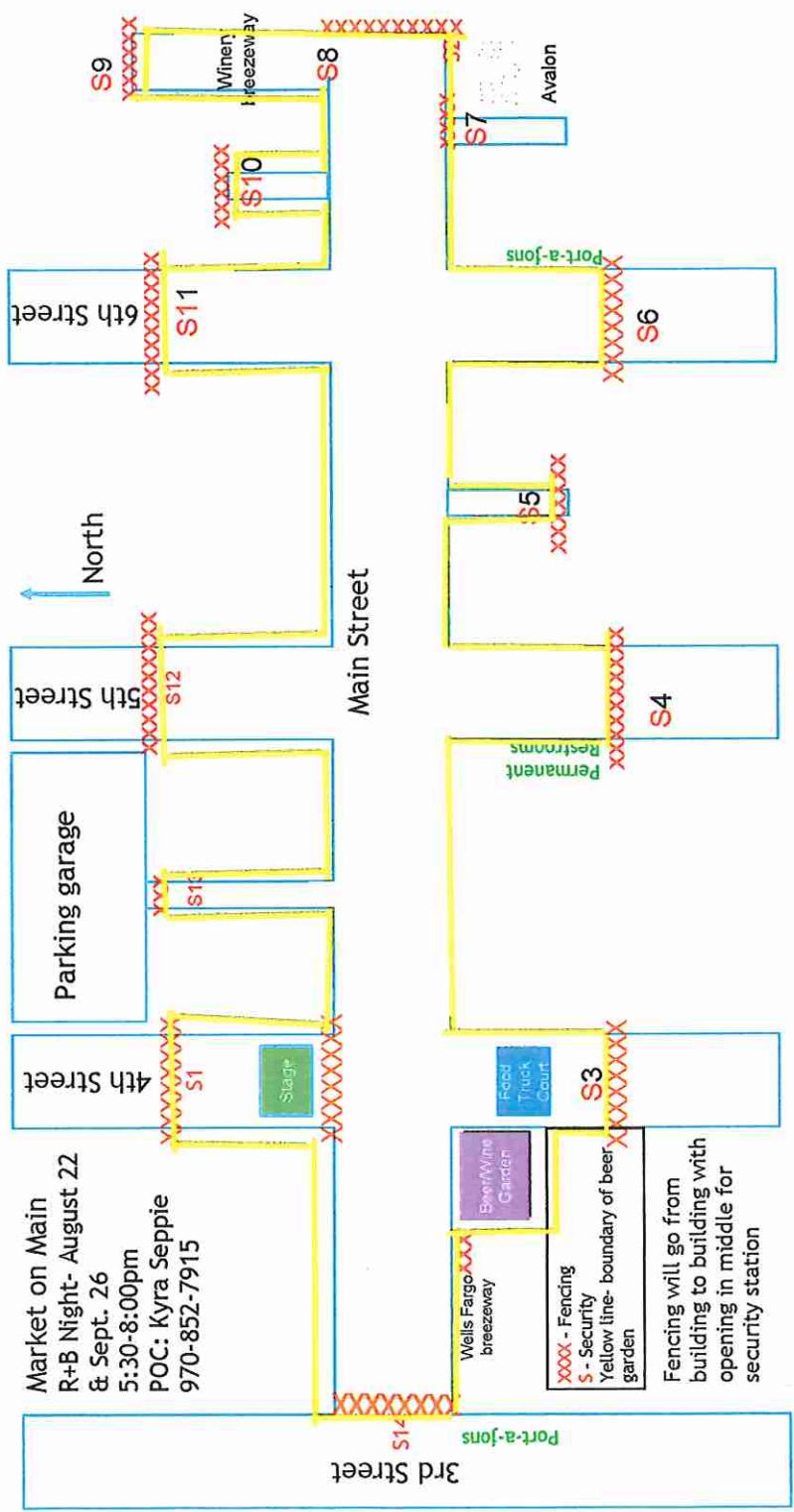

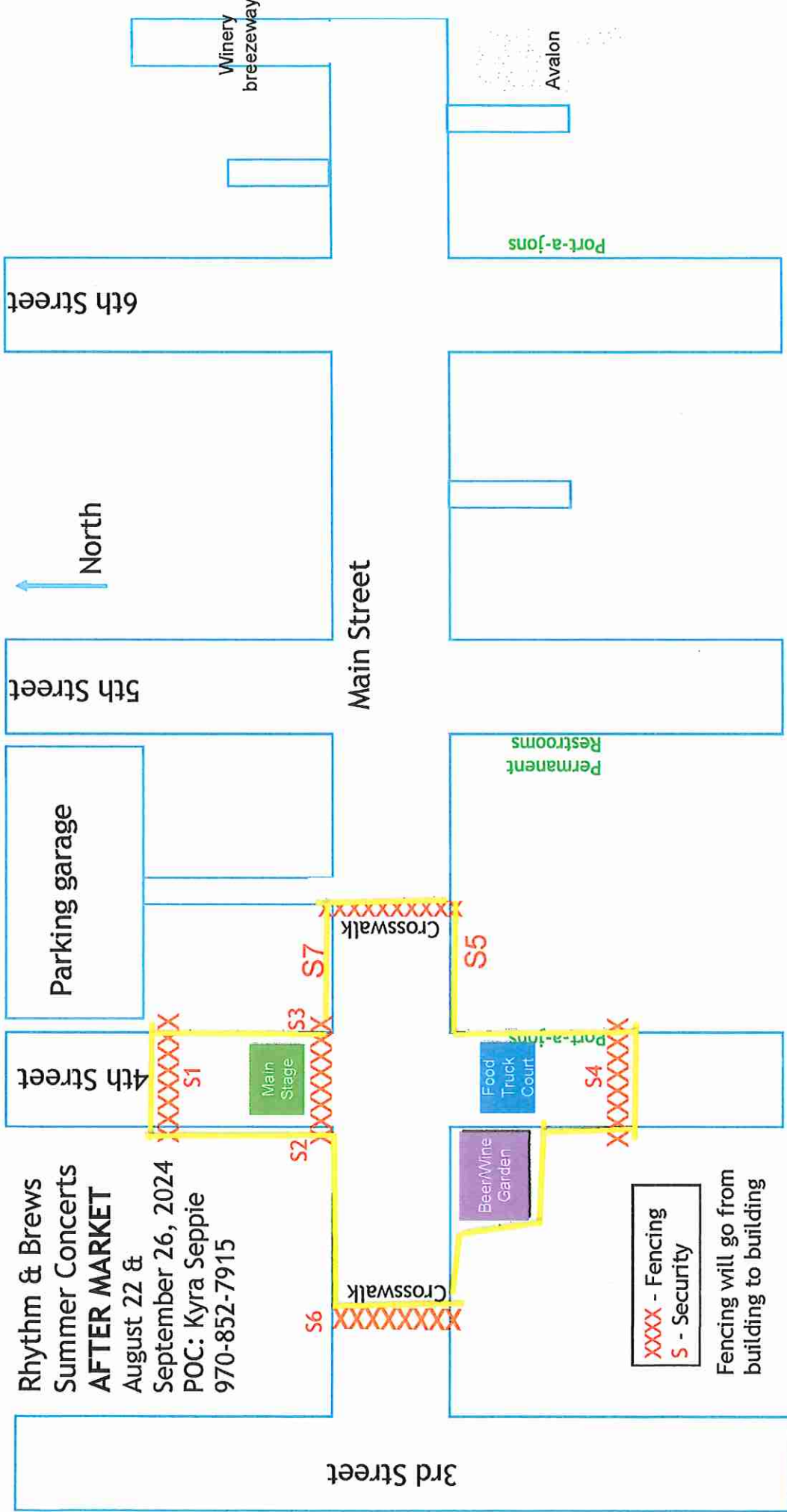
