## Other items:

- David Varner has made initial contact with property owners from whom we'd need an easement to access the Clifton Water property. Clifton water supports multiple routes for the trial through their property. However two of the property owners contacted by David have indicated that they would not support a trail easement. The southernmost owner has concerns about property access to the south (animals equipment), which may be mitigated with appropriate infrastructure.
