Updates:

- Oral History Michele and Nicole to follow up and report back at the next meeting.
- Social Media Marketing Sarah is posting regularly. She has been posting on Stefanie and Jamie's spots because they were often left open. Sarah doesn't think that there is enough people to help with a bike ride and skills clinic on Oct 12 and GVSA has still not gotten back to me or confirmed that they plan to help. She is going to plan a regular ride on Oct 12, will coordinate with Jane on distance and details and send out to everyone. She would still like to do a bike skills, rules of the road, and basic maintenance event in conjunction with a ride, but she thinks we should try to plan it for the spring. Meg wondered if CMU cycling club would be interested in helping with the clinic.
