Your Available Fertility Benefit

An infertility diagnosis is required to utilize the benefit. Working with your doctor can help determine the best next steps based on your available benefits.

For your fertility benefits, you have access to:

- Testing to determine the cause of infertility, if applicable
- · Treatment to restore fertility
- Once infertility has been diagnosed, you are also able to utilize Artificial Insemination/Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) and/or IVF

What is not covered through Cigna Healthcare?

Cigna Healthcare does not cover infertility services or tests that are considered experimental, investigational, unproven or not medically necessary.

In addition, the following services will most likely not be covered by your medical plan:

- Services associated with the reversal of voluntary sterilization
- Infertility services when the infertility is caused by or related to voluntary sterilization
- Donor charges, fees and services, including services associated with donor sperm and donor oocytes
- Fees to a gestational carrier
- Over the counter ovulation test kits or pregnancy test kits
