RE: 2025 Contract Street Maintenance Overlays IFB-5560-25-DD

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded, and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following questions/answers/clarifications:

- 1. Question: What is the City's plan for the rough, uneven surface at the patch locations on South Pinon and South Cedar? Will these locations/streets be a full width mill to help smooth up the road? Answer: South Pinon and South Cedar will be a full width mill.
- Question: What would the City like for all the core holes and dips on Unaweep side streets, which have settled? Will the City add a Pre-Level quantity to the project tabulation?
 Answer: Pre-level quantity as directed has been added as line item #16 (See revised Bid Specification Sheet attached)
- **3. Question:** Will the Cul-De-Sac on North Pine be overlaid? The plan sheet is cut off and not showing any work to continue through the Cul-De-Sac.

Answer: All North Pine will be overlaid, including the cul-de-sac bulb.

4. Question: The assumption is all existing Asphalt, and concrete driveways shall be milled for tie-ins on the Unaweep side streets. What transition is the City proposing without the full width milling taking place?

Answer: Line item #18 added to address tie ins to existing hard surfaces, as directed. (See revised Bid Specification Sheet attached)

Clarification: A sheet showing the approximate quantities per street has been added for bidders'
convenience. Please note that some line items are accounted for in bulk and may not be shown per
street. (Attached)

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted. All other conditions of the subject remain the same.
