Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded, and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following questions/answers/clarifications:

Question: Addendum 1 released (item 5) "Clarification" sheet showing the approximate quantities per street. The sheet calculates asphalt removal (planing) (1.5" typical) per street but the aggregate amount does not match the Bid Schedule quantity of 40,750 SY. Are we to bid the bid schedule amount or the tabulation amount on the "clarification" sheet?
Answer: Bid Tabulation revised to address quantity error in Item No 1. Asphalt Removal (Planing)(1.5" Typical). All bids should be made with respect to the quantities shown on the Bid Schedule, any supplemental material tabulations are for the bidder's consideration but do not take

precedence from the Bid Schedule.
