SUBJECT: Sole Source for Orchard Mesa Pool Boiler Replacement

The Orchard Mesa Pool boiler has failed. Attempts to repair the boiler over the past several days have been unsuccessful and the boiler has been determined to be unrepairable. The boiler also broke down last year leading to a multiple week closure. Efforts are in motion to procure a new boiler. In the meantime, the solar energy heating system is keeping temperatures in the 70s, which is cooler than usual and may be uncomfortable for some swimmers. Unfortunately, over this weekend, the pool water dropped to 71 degrees forcing the facility to close to swimmers. It is anticipated that the facility will remain closed until a new boiler is installed.

Given this closure, a new boiler must be procured as soon as possible. The city recently procured the Lincoln Park supplemental boiler, which was installed in spring of 2024. The plan is to use elements of this procurement to aid in acquiring and installing a new boiler for the Orchard Mesa Pool.

Although the facility is owned by School District #51, per the recent agreement with District #51, fixing the pool in instances like these are at the discretion and obligation of the City. To avoid a lengthy interruption in service, and no other alternative with the Community Recreation Center and its aquatic offerings still under construction, this crucial piece of equipment needs to be procured as soon as possible. It is important to note that care is being taken to ensure that the new boiler at Orchard Mesa Pool is transferable to the Lincoln Park Pool whose original boiler is a similar age to the Orchard Mesa Pool boiler that just failed.

This purchase is covered by the Conservation Trust Fund, 2025 budget contingency or existing appropriated funds in the 201 depending on finance direction.
