Proclamation

Thereas, Arts and Humanities is an integral part of the communities throughout this country, including the City of Grand Junction; and

The Grand Junction area represents hundreds of arts and cultural organizations which celebrate the value and importance of arts in culture within the community contributing to the quality of life and economic wellbeing of Grand Junction and the region; and

Thereas, the arts and humanities embody so much of the accumulated wisdom, intellect, and imagination of humankind, and

Whereas, the arts and humanities enhance and enrich the lives of everyone in America, and

Thereas, the arts and humanities play a unique role in the lives of our families, our communities, and our country, and

the creative industries remain among the most vital sectors of the American economy providing new opportunities for developing cities, creating jobs and economic activity within their own industry and across sectors, and making communities attractive to business development, and

Grand Junction area arts and culture organizations alone generate \$13.2 million in government revenue and \$28.4 million in economic activity (2022) annually by organizations and audiences-including spending by attendees to arts events of \$50.05 per person, per event, beyond the cost of admission on items such as meals, parking, and lodging, making the arts a vital income source for local businesses, and

Whereas, Americans for the Arts has designated October as National Arts and Humanities Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Cody Kennedy, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 2025 as

"Arts and Humanities Month"

in the City of Grand Junction and call upon our community members to celebrate and promote the arts and culture in our community.
