I. <u>Call to Order</u>

II. <u>License Renewal Applications with Late Filing</u>

 Struthers Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – Retail – 26 Days Late

Hearing Officer Starritt stated that he had reviewed the applicant's submitted City renewal application. He then asked if Officer Wright had any concerns regarding the renewal. Officer Wright wasn't present, but Mrs. Koehler reported that there were no areas of concern. Hearing Officer Starritt then verified with Mrs. Koehler that the updated Oaths of Applicant forms had been completed and received, and that the application was complete. There was also discussion about why Colorado Weedery was late in submitting its renewal. The delay occurred because, while the state issues two-year licenses with a 90-day renewal period, she forgot that the local license requires annual renewal. A plan is now in place to ensure late renewals do not occur in the future. Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone present would like to speak regarding the renewals. There was no one.
