The application for the special event permit submitted Habitat for Humanity of Mesa County "Hope Through Homes - 2025" was in order and approved.

will be set in place. No weapons allowed, no outside alcohol permitted. A perimeter will be set around the
event and the entrance will be staffed with volunteers and secuirty to issue wristbands and to check for
prohibitied items. Should any incident occur hired security will be involved to escort participant(s) out of the
event and police will be notified. Security will be present through the event.
8. How will security personnel be identified?
Security Personnel will have identifiable security t-shirts to wear during the event.
9. If this event is an outdoor event, how will the exterior boundaries of the premises be marked (i.e., roped, fenced, etc.)?
Exterior boundaries of the presmises will be marked with cones and orange fenciing.

We will do a stat I.D check for all participants. There will be two different color wristbands identifying
underage patrons and age-verified patrons.

All staff and security will be monitoring guests during the entirety of the event.

Staff and volunteers will not be serving alcohol, but vendors will be trained and TIPS certified.
