The FCI Safety Guidelines

FCI's Safety Guidelines Document is 211 pages. Upon award, the Contractor must agree to FCI's entire Safety Guidelines Document.

- a. The installing Contractor is expected to adhere to FCI safety requirements while onsite. Any contractors working onsite will be required to wear safety vest, hard hat, boots, and eye protection always. Shorts and cut-off shirts are not allowed. A safety orientation will be required once the Contractor arrives onsite. (This would only be needed if the installation happens PRIOR to obtaining the Certificate of Occupancy)
- b. FCI cannot guarantee that it will have hoisting or lift equipment to unload, stage, or place materials. The Contractor must include any lifts, forklifts, etc. required for its own materials and installations.
