RE: Pre-Employment Health Screening and Drug Testing Services for the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, RFP-5759-25-KF

Proposers responding to the above-referenced solicitation are hereby advised that certain requirements have been **clarified, modified, or supplemented** as of the date of this Addendum, as outlined below.

Please take note of the following clarifications:

1. **Revised Attachment A – Furniture RFP Response Spreadsheet**

All Proposers are required to use the **Revised Attachment A – Pricing Table** issued with Addendum 2. This updated version incorporates the City's standard seven (7)-panel non-DOT drug test and adds clarification fields to ensure consistency and comparability in pricing submissions.

Proposers **must** use the revised spreadsheet (linked below) when preparing and submitting its pricing proposals.

2. **Question:** The RFP specifies the use of a non-DOT 5-panel, 10-panel, and 12-panel. Unlike DOT testing, non-DOT drug panels and cutoff levels are not standardized across laboratories. A "non-DOT 5-panel" can vary significantly in its composition. Proposers can assume that the non-DOT 5-panel mirrors the Federal DOT 5-panel (THC, cocaine, amphetamines, opiates, and PCP); however, non-DOT panels may include expanded analytes or different cutoff levels depending on the City's requirements. These variations materially affect laboratory configuration, turnaround times, and pricing.

To ensure that our proposal is accurate and fully responsive, we respectfully request clarification on the following:

Please provide the specific analytes required for each of the following non-DOT panels:

- Non-DOT 5-panel
- Non-DOT 10-panel
- Non-DOT 12-panel

Answer: For all non-DOT panels (5-panel, 10-panel, and 12-panel), the City does not currently prescribe specific analytes. While the City's standard pre-employment panel is a defined 7-panel (included in the revised Attachment A), the City may consider adjusting its standard panel in the future based on defined analytes and cutoff levels.

Accordingly, Proposers shall complete all required fields in the Revised Attachment A – Pricing Table, including:

- The analytes included in each proposed non-DOT panel
- The cutoff levels for each analyte
- Whether confirmatory testing is included

This information is required to ensure comparability among Proposers and accurate evaluation of pricing and laboratory configuration.

3. **Question:** Please confirm whether the City requires defined cutoff levels for each analyte, or whether our assumption of reasonable levels should be made.

Answer: The City requires defined cutoff levels.

4. **Question:** If the City has previously used specific non-DOT panels or has preferred configurations, providing those details or a sample panel sheet would allow Proposers to price the requested services accurately.

Answer: Please refer to **Addendum No. 1, Question 7**, which provides the City's required drug panel configurations.

No further questions will be accepted at this time.

This addendum amends the original solicitation for the referenced project as outlined above. All other terms and conditions of the solicitation remain unchanged.

Proposers must acknowledge receipt of this addendum by completing the acknowledgment section on the **Solicitation Response Form** (Section 7.0).
