## **ADDENDUM NO. 2**

RE: Patterson Sidewalk 24 ½ Rd – 25 ½ Rd IFB-5743-26-KN

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

1. **Q:** I still can't find any info on the line-item Pedestrian Push Button (49) can you please help point me in the right direction, also just a suggestion, there should be a set footage for the 2 inch bore for under the driveways only. The 6000 ft is to bore the whole project which is not the intent. (like 7 streets for 7 bores of 70ft so roughly 500ft) example only.

**A:** Below are the links to the revised sheets highlighting the pedestrian push button callouts. Line item 44 is intended as an alternative method of installation for 2 inch electrical conduit at the direction of the Engineer.

- 2. **Q:** Where are the sod removal and abandon irrigation system line-item quantities attributed?
  - A: Sod removal and abandon irrigation system in place are for Parcel 13, C&F Food Stores.
- 3. Q: In the electrical drawings it calls out for collision break away bolts. The lighting supplier is sending out a quote without the breakaways included, stating that they are not required for this project. The Four Canyons project required them as well. Can you please verify that they will be required as per electrical spec or not
  - A: Break away bolts will not be required for this project.
- 4. **Q:** Addendum 1 posted without the bid schedule and then it was posted again with the bid schedule. In Bidnet they are two separate addendums (1 & 2), but when you open them, they both say 1. How many should we acknowledge in the bid documents?

**A:** Contractor shall acknowledge two addendums even though it will look like three are in Bidnet after this one has been posted.

5. **Q:** In the addendum it states the "Submittal deadline for proposals" is December 23, 2025. However, in Bidnet they are still due this Friday. Will this be corrected in Bidnet?

A: Bidnet has been updated to reflect the new bid opening date.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
