RESOLUTION NO. 58-26
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2026 MESA COUNTY, COLORADO HAZARD
MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Junction recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community. The City recognizes the importance in undertaking hazard mitigation actions to reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences. The adoption of the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post- disaster mitigation grant programs if the City is participating in mitigations projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Junction, as part of a multi-jurisdictional effort, has helped in the preparation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act as amended; and

WHEREAS, the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan identified mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property within the City of Grand Junction from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII, officials have reviewed the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan and have approved said plan as meeting the requirements of 44 C.F.R. 201.6. City of Grand Junction staff fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan and recommends approval by the City of Grand Junction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GRAND
JUNCTION, COLORADO:

1. The City Council hereby adopts the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan as the multi-hazard mitigation plan for the City of Grand Junction; and
2. The City of Grand Junction is committed to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2026 Mesa County Hazard Mitigation Plan.
